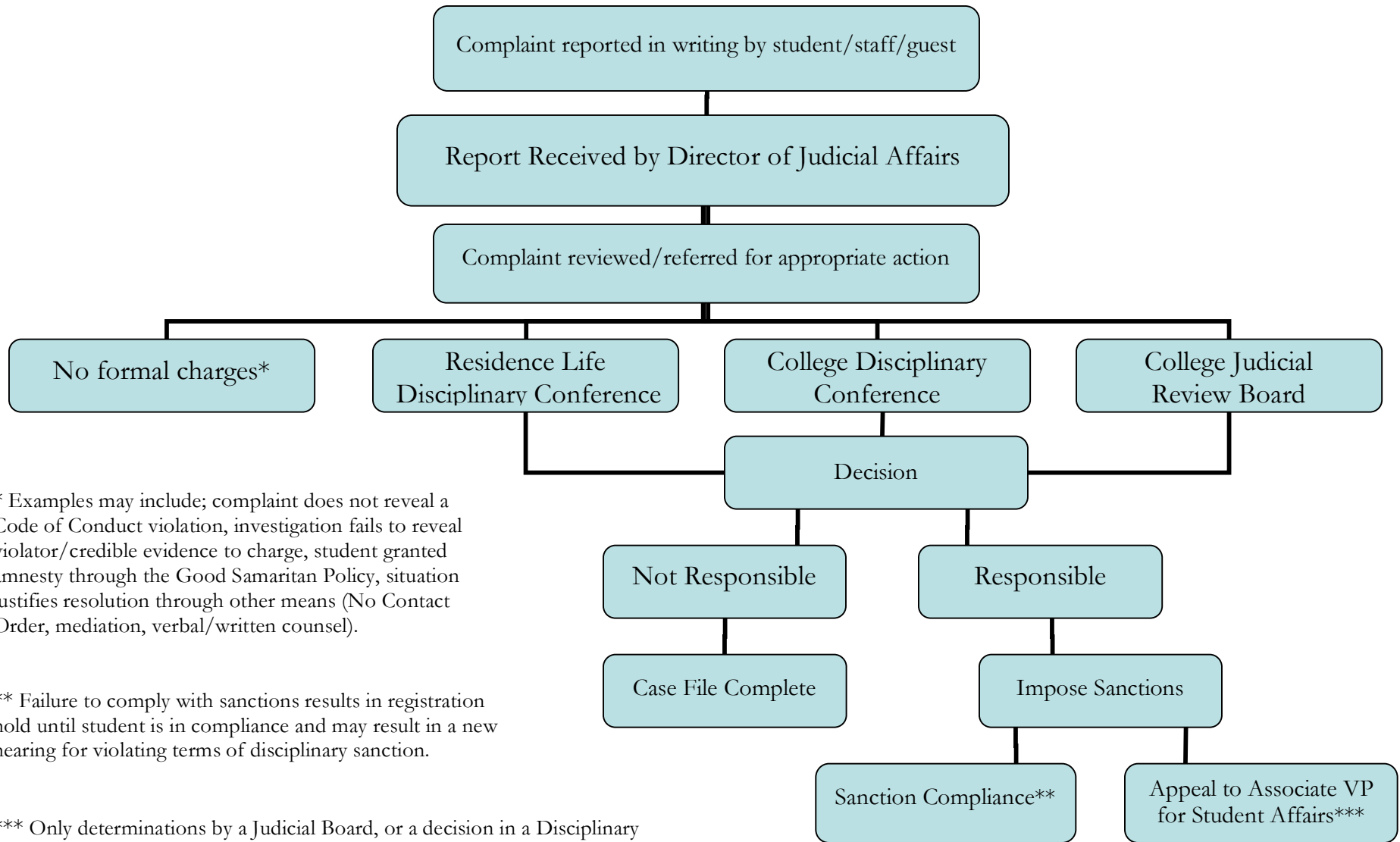


Office of Judicial Affairs Judicial Charges Flowchart



* Examples may include; complaint does not reveal a Code of Conduct violation, investigation fails to reveal violator/credible evidence to charge, student granted amnesty through the Good Samaritan Policy, situation justifies resolution through other means (No Contact Order, mediation, verbal/written counsel).

** Failure to comply with sanctions results in registration hold until student is in compliance and may result in a new hearing for violating terms of disciplinary sanction.

*** Only determinations by a Judicial Board, or a decision in a Disciplinary Conference which suspends campus housing privileges may be appealed. The decision of the Associate VP for Student Affairs is final. Cases of academic dishonesty are appealed to the Provost.
