Recording Senior Presentations

- Susan responded to our questions and offered the following guidance for recording senior presentations (in red):
- If faculty record the presentation/class and the recording is going to be used only for assessment purposes, then no waivers are needed. These videos should be destroyed/deleted after the assessment is completed and definitely not posted online, on Canvas, or on social media or shared with anyone other than those directly involved with the task of assessment. Students in the class should be informed that these videos will only be used for assessment and then destroyed and only the instructor will ever see them or have access to them.
- If faculty other than the professor sit in the class to assess and it is NOT recorded, no waivers are needed (similar to a class visitation) Correct
- If students record on their own and send to the professor, waivers do not need to be signed if the purpose of sharing is for assessment only. Correct
- I <u>updated</u> our memo accordingly. I left in Mike Tripodi's guidance about other recording issues (e.g., recording sessions using other software or for posting recordings on Canvas).
