## Rules Change for the Final Round for 2<sup>nd</sup> District Fed Challenge

(Please note: Rules for the national finals at the Board of Governors will remain unchanged.

Based upon the successful pilot in the  $2^{nd}$  District High School Fed Challenge, starting in fall 2012, the FINAL round of the  $2^{nd}$  District College Fed Challenge will consist of a five minute presentation and a 25 minute period of questions and answers. This will preserve the 30-minute overall time frame. Earlier rounds will continue with the previous time distribution of x minutes for presentation and x minutes for Q&A, as will the national finals at the Board of Governors.

This change was approved unanimously by the EEA College Fed Challenge Advisory Board after soliciting and incorporating feedback from constituents. See additional details on the new format, below.

## **Final Round Presentation (5 minutes)**

Students will be asked to provide a five minute expedited explanation of their position on monetary policy. Judges will be given the team's full presentation slides ahead of time.

## Final Round Questions and Answers (25 minutes)

Judges would be asked to ask standard questions (asked of all teams in the finals), questions on general monetary policy issues, and questions as follow-ups to the presentations.
