

## Learning Goal and Measurable SLOs for the Course Enrichment Component

ARC and Design Team, March 23 2011

**Goal:** Each student will participate in five or more hours of unmonitored experience(s) outside the classroom designed to enhance student learning in the course.

### Outcomes

(All courses should include one or both of these outcomes, as appropriate)

- *demonstrate* how an out-of-class activity applies knowledge obtained in the classroom
  - o The activity would be a hands-on / minds-on activity, e.g. fieldwork, lab-type activity, creative work, etc.
  - o Examples of Instruments (assignments): a lab / field report; embedded question(s) on exams; research material incorporated into existing paper as a source; oral presentations/reports; creative works.
- *Demonstrate* how your learning of the course material is connected to and enhanced by the out-of-class activity
  - o Examples of Instruments: reflection paper; embedded question(s) on exams; research material incorporated into existing paper as a source<sup>1</sup>; oral presentations/reports

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<sup>1</sup> E.g. assignments where students conduct interviews outside of the classroom, and use those interviews as primary sources
