Proposal for Program Revision: Digital Journalism and Writing Concentration

As of Fall 2021, the Journalism concentration is proposing revising the program to become the Digital Journalism and Writing concentration within the Communication Arts major. While the major will remain the same, the revised concentration will focus on digital storytelling across the newly-combined genres. The name of the revised concentration will be **Digital Journalism and Writing.**

The renamed Digital Journalism and Writing Concentration will offer students options to study the crafts of journalism and writing in order to prepare them to be effective multimedia storytellers who are grounded in accurate information gathering, sound writing practices, and ethical decision-making. Students will be able to deliver news and creative works using the latest emerging technology.

The revised concentration will provide students with opportunities to practice journalism and writing for websites, blogs, newspapers, magazines, and other media outlets. They can pursue interests in journalistic writing, or develop long-form writing projects. As they progress, students will learn multimedia techniques with an emphasis on audio, visual, and immersive storytelling as well as digital production.

The Journalism and Writing faculty, three in total, will combine their expertise as journalists and editors working in newspapers, magazines, broadcast outlets and websites to offer students a comprehensive course of study in journalism and various types of long-form narrative writing and analysis that are in demand in the media workplace today.
