- What Does GECCo Do As Part of Its Charge?

 - Review Course Proposals For Inclusion Within The GE program
 - Directors & Coordinators Collect Assignments From From Faculty Who Teach In Their Respective Categories

 - Hold workshops about the GE Program

 - Attend GE Workshops & Meet With Category Coordinators
 - Revise Assignments If Necessary
- **Issue:** Incomplete Curriculum Assessment Teams Delays Assessment
 - Join A CAT
- **Issue:** GE Category Coordinators Vacancies
 - Become A Rep (Or At Large)
