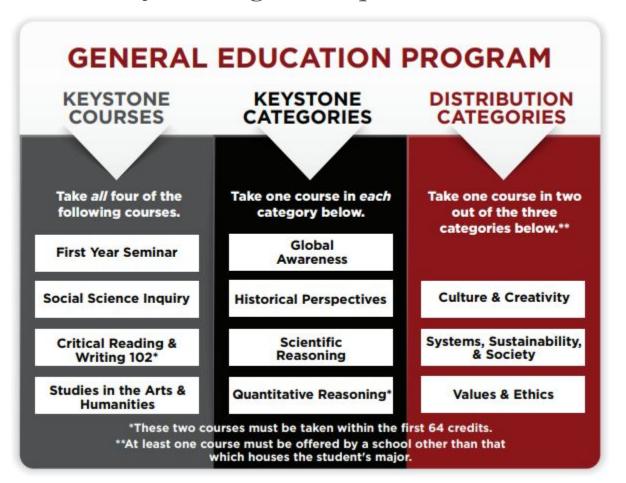

 - Attend GE Workshops & Meet With Category Coordinators
 - Revise Assignments If Necessary
- Issue: Incomplete Curriculum Assessment Teams Delays Assessment
 - O Join A CAT
- Issue: GE Category Coordinators Vacancies
 - Become A Rep (Or At Large)
