2) A change to the course requirements and title of the SSS category:

### **Social Systems and Society**

The course should be at the 100/200/300 level. **Note:** Courses submitted and approved for inclusion in this Distribution Category will be at the 100, 200, or 300 level. Courses at the 100 level should still build on topics in the Keystone courses (likely SSI). The prereqs, if present, must be in the Keystone courses (First Year Seminar, Studies in the Arts and Humanities, Critical Reading and Writing II, Historical Perspectives, Global Awareness, Scientific Reasoning, Social Science Inquiry, Quantitative Reasoning or Social Science Inquiry).

3) A change to the curriculum map for some objectives (TBA).
