# GENERAL CLEANING AND DISINFECTION GUIDELINES FOR ALL CAMPUS FACULTY, STAFF & STUDENTS

The following is a summary for cleaning and disinfecting various types of spaces, objects, and transportation. The list below is meant as a general guideline and does not include or represent all cleaned and disinfected areas. Disinfecting wipes are provided throughout campus for personal use.

| Bathroom   | All objects and surfaces  | Building Services        | Minimum twice daily               |
| Classrooms/labs/<br>studios/meeting<br>rooms   | Desks, chair surfaces, white board markers, WebEx Room Kits, projector remotes and other high-touch surfaces                    | Instructors and students | Before class                      |
|  |   | Building Services        | Once Daily                        |
| Common office spaces/suites  | Copiers, printers, file cabinets, switches, counter-tops, and other frequently touched objects                                  | Each user                | Before each use                   |
|  |   | Building Services        | Once Daily                        |
| Private/personal offices/cubicles  | Telephones, keyboards, desks, and other frequently touched objects  | Each user                | While occupying area              |
| Public spaces (e.g. lobbies, hallways, elevators, stairwells, bathrooms, etc.)         | Door handles and knobs,<br>buttons, handrails, and other<br>frequently touched objects  | Building Services        | Multiple times throughout the day |
| Study Spaces<br>(including reservable<br>study rooms and<br>computer labs),<br>studios | Chairs, desks, tables, and other frequently high-touched surfaces   | Each user                | Before each use                   |
|  |   | Building Services        | Once daily                        |
| Athletics, Fitness<br>Centers, Sports &<br>Recreation                                  | Fitness and sports equipment  | Each user                | Before each use                   |
| Athletics, Fitness<br>Centers, Sports &<br>Recreation                                  | High-touch areas (bathrooms, desks, chairs, fitness equipment)  | Building Services        | Multiple times throughout the day |
| Athletics, Fitness<br>Centers, Sports &<br>Recreation                                  | Locker Rooms and Bathrooms  | Building Services        | Minimum twice daily               |

| Tools   | All surfaces typically handled   | Each user | Before each use |

| Vehicles  | Steering wheel, dashboard, seats, belt buckles, lights, directionals, door handles | Each user | Before each use |
| Material handling equipment (e.g. forklifts, pallet jacks, skidsteer) | Seats, steering wheels, levers, and all other high-touch surfaces                  | Each user | Before each use |
