



CANADA GOOSE

- Canada Goose is a Toronto based company that specializes in making fur and down winter coats.
- Canada Goose actively gets their fur and down from exploited animals such as coyotes and geese that are unethically killed and skinned.
- They use real coyote fur trims from coyotes trapped in the wild who suffer great pain and distress.
- The fur is purchased from other Canadian-based companies such as Manitoba's James Valley Colony Farms [®]JVC[©] which breeds 130,000 geese a year.
- At the goose slaughterhouse workers shackle the ducks and geese hang them upside down and slit their throats as the other birds watch.
- Although Canada Goose denies these claims. There is a lot of evidence to prove otherwise. Organizations such as PETA®People for Ethical Treatment of Animals© have started campaigns to expose Canada Goose and to try to put an end to the unfair treatment of animals needed to produce their famous coats.
