Recommended Four-Year Plan (Fall 2013)

The recommended four-year plan is designed to provide a blueprint for students to complete their degrees within four years. These plans are the recommended sequences of courses. If developmental courses are needed, students may have additional requirements to fulfill which are not listed in the plan.
