

Spanish Language Studies -- Recommended Four-Year Plan (Fall 2019)

The recommended four-year plan is designed to provide a blueprint for students to complete their degrees within four years. These plans are the recommended sequences of courses. Students must meet with their Major Advisor to develop a more individualized plan to complete their degree. This plan assumes that no developmental courses are required. If developmental courses are needed, students may have additional requirements to fulfill, which are not listed in the plan. For instance, students who are placed in the intermediate level, will start the language sequence in their second year. Course offerings may vary from year to year.

NOTE: This recommended Four-Year Plan is applicable to students admitted into the major during the 2019-2020 academic year.
