7 THINGS YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT THE RESCISSION OF DACA

- INITIAL DACA APPLICATIONS SUBMITTED <u>BEFORE</u> SEPTEMBER 5, 2017 WILL BE CONSIDERED ON A CASE-BY-CASE BASIS AND PROCESSED AS USUAL.
- <u>NO NEW INITIAL APPLICATIONS</u>. ALL INITIAL DACA APPLICATIONS DATED SEPTEMBER 5, 2017 AND AFTERWARDS WILL BE REJECTED.
- DACA AUTHORIZATIONS THAT HAVE BEEN ISSUED ALREADY WILL NOT BE REVOKED. WORK AUTHORIZATIONS ARE VALID UNTIL THE EXPIRATION DATE LISTED ON THE CARD.
- ANY DACA AUTHORIZATIONS THAT WILL EXPIRE <u>BETWEEN SEPTEMBER 5, 2017 AND MARCH 5, 2018</u> CAN BE RENEWED AS LONG AS THE RENEWAL IS SUBMITTED BY OCTOBER 5, 2017.
- ANY ADVANCE PAROLE REQUEST THAT HAS ALREADY BEEN APPROVED IS STILL VALID. (BUT IT IS NOT RECOMMENDED TO TRAVEL OUTSIDE THE U.S. AT THIS TIME.)
- NO NEW ADVANCE PAROLE APPLICATIONS WILL BE PROCESSED, ALL PENDING APPLICATIONS WILL BE ADMINISTRATIVELY CLOSED AND THE FEES REFUNDED.
- DHS STILL MAINTAINS THE DISCRETIONARY AUTHORITY TO DO WHATEVER IT WANTS TO.
