

## **Campus Hazing Transparency Report**

Updated March 19, 2026

The report includes the name of the organization, the date of violation/charge, the actual charge, a general description of the incident, findings and sanctions placed on the organization, and the date it was resolved. Ramapo College will publish this updated report twice a year on or before January 1st and July 1st and include all information concerning violations that have taken place within 5 years time.

Hazing Charges: There have been no hazing charges in the past 5 years.

Other Charges: Listed below are other organizational charges in the past 5 years.

### **Alpha Phi Delta**

**Charge:** Violation of published Federal, State, or local laws or of College regulations or policies (Greek Policies and Procedures)

**Date of violation:** Spring 2026

**Date of charge:** March 16, 2026

**Date investigation began:** November 25, 2025

**Date investigation ended:** December 8, 2025

**Description of Violation:** Hosted an unauthorized new member process with students who did not meet eligibility requirements set by the Office of Fraternity and Sorority Life.

**Finding:** Responsible

**Description of Sanction:** The chapter is suspended effective immediately through January 17, 2028. During the period of suspension an organization does not have the privileges afforded to a registered organization, including, but not limited to: participate in recruitment, including bid and new member processes; hold events; reserve rooms; hold chapter meetings; request funds

from allocations, fundraise or do philanthropies; and participate as an organization in any activities sponsored by or affiliated with the college. Following Suspension, the chapter will be placed on Probation until January 1, 2030. Probation is a defined period of time whereby an organization is given an opportunity to modify their behavior or risk more severe sanctions. Any subsequent violation of the Code of Conduct or other college policies, while in this status, will likely result in expulsion from the College. Alpha Phi Delta will not be permitted to recruit new members until the fall semester of 2028.

### **Alpha Phi Delta**

**Charge:** Violation of published Federal, State, or local laws or of College regulations or policies (Greek Policies and Procedures)

**Date of violation:** Fall 2023

**Date of charge:** January 31st, 2024

**Date investigation began:** February 2nd, 2024

**Date investigation ended:** February 2nd, 2024

**Description of Violation:** Hosted an unauthorized new member process with students who did not meet eligibility requirements set by the Office of Fraternity and Sorority Life

**Finding:** Responsible

**Description of Sanction:** The Chapter was on probation through January 1st, 2025. Probation is a defined period of time whereby a registered organization is given an opportunity to modify their behavior or risk losing status as a registered organization. Any subsequent violation of the Code of Conduct or other college policies, while in this status, will likely result in expulsion from the College. Any members who did not participate in the Office of Fraternity and Sorority Life's mandated process for potential new members were required to complete that process during the next approved new member process.
