

## Facts About Chlamydia\*



- A common STD that can infect men and women
- Spread via vaginal, anal or oral sex with an infected person if protection is not used
- Increased risk factors include:
  - Younger age
  - Men who have sex with men

### State of NJ Statistics (Calendar year 2017)

Total rate of Chlamydia infection in NJ clinics in men: 9.7%

Total rate of Chlamydia infection in NJ clinics in women: 7.3%

Total rate of Chlamydia infection at RCNJ in men: 13.0%

Total rate of Chlamydia infection at RCNJ in women: 5.8%

### Signs and Symptoms

- Most people have none
- In women, an abnormal vaginal discharge or burning sensation with urination
- In men, a discharge from their penis, burning with urination, or pain and swelling in one or both testicles

### Testing and Treatment

- A urine sample can detect infection
- Chlamydia can be cured with treatment
