



## CONTACT TRACING INFORMATION

Contact Tracing will be conducted internally for Ramapo College in partnership with the State of NJ with representatives from various State Agencies, specifically Mahwah Department of Health/Bergen County Department of Health. It is an essential tool used to help prevent the spread of COVID-19.

Four contact tracers from Human Resources, Joanne Ehlermann, Jill Brown, Brittany Ring and Virginia Galdieri, have been trained by Johns Hopkins University to conduct contact tracing for COVID-19 cases. If you are contacted by one of our Contact Tracers or the Bergen County Department of Health, it is imperative that you cooperate and provide timely, accurate information. This will minimize those exposed and hopefully slow the spread of the virus.
