Dear Colleague:

As we wrap up the spring semester and begin preparations for the fall, I want to share an update regarding the current Roadrunner/Arch staffing model. Effective May 24, 2021 (Roadrunner Week), the week after Commencement, our four-day flex summer schedule will begin. At that time, the Roadrunner/Arch model will consist of staff working four days per week on campus followed by four days remote on the alternating week. All essential workers should be guided by their Supervisor regarding their summer schedule.

Please begin to plan for the start of the summer flex weeks and make note that the holiday weeks of May 31 and July 4 will consist of on campus operations on Tuesday-Thursday with extended hours of 8:00 a.m-5:45 p.m. Juneteenth, Friday, June 18th, 2021 is a holiday, and normal business hours will be in effect Monday through Thursday. Some of you may be aware that the Governor's Office on Monday, April 5 announced the availability of the COVID-19 vaccine for all who work in higher education.
