Use Canvas for course materials, communication, assignments, and grading. □ Explore Faculty Resource Center (FRC) for teaching resources and development. □ Use Instructional Design Center (IDC) for online teaching, classroom tech, and Al tools. □ Confirm textbook orders through the Ramapo Bookstore. □ When applicable, place course reserves with the George T. Potter Library. □ When applicable, coordinate accommodations with Office of Specialized Services (OSS).
\square When applicable, follow procedures for <u>independent study</u> and <u>study abroad</u> .
Teaching & Grading
 □ Follow Ramapo's official <u>Grading System</u> and <u>Grading Options</u>. □ Report violations under the <u>Academic Integrity Policy</u>. □ Submit final grades in <u>Web Self-Service</u>.

 □ Review ARC (Academic Review Committee) for the curriculum procedure & CourseDog. □ Review GECCo (General Edu Curriculum Committee) for Gen Ed structure and expectation. □ Review WAC (Writing Across the Curriculum) & FYS (First Year Seminar) for their guidelines □ Review CWAAC (college-wide academic assessment committee) for its guidlines.

Advising & Student Support
