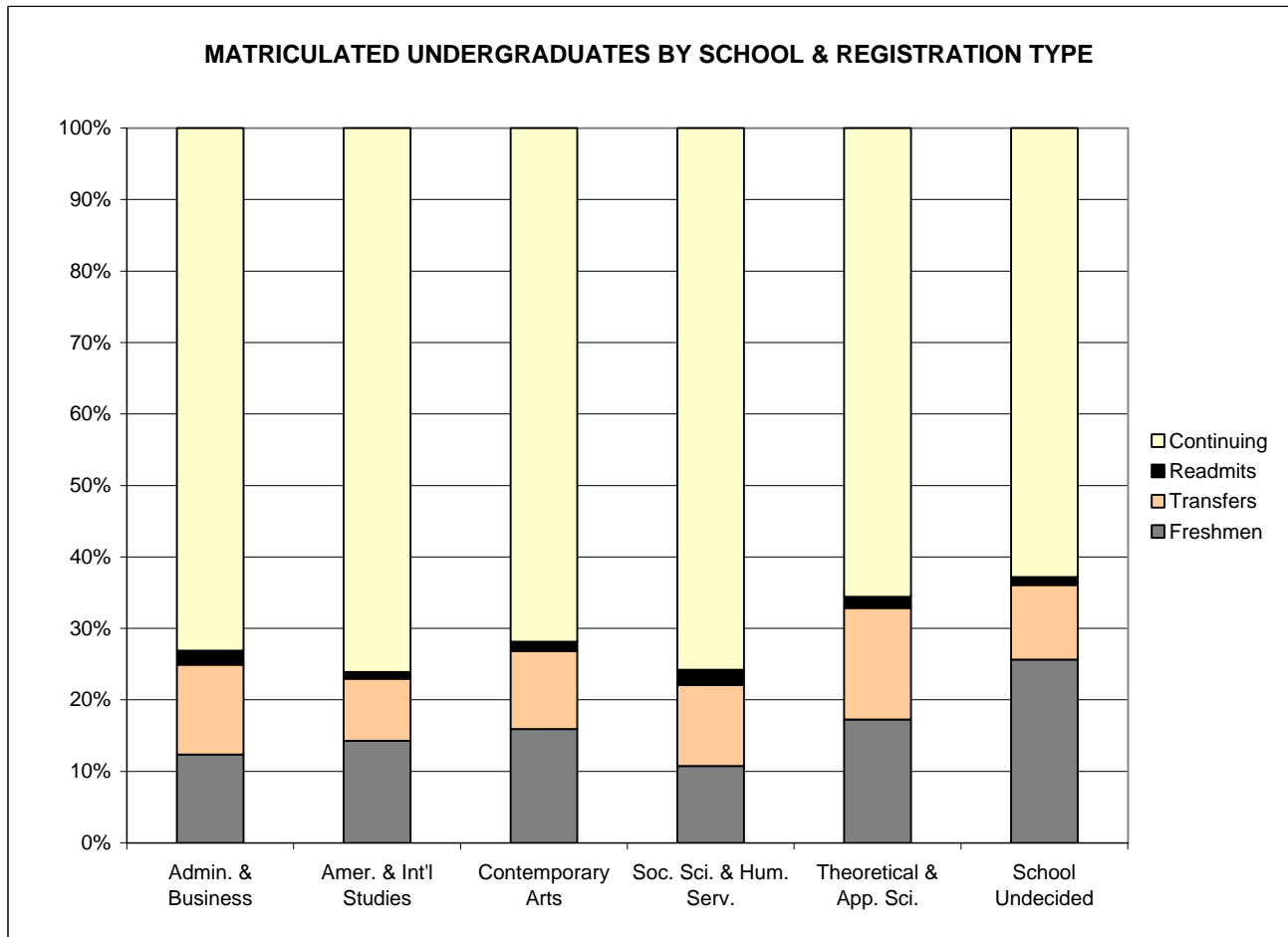

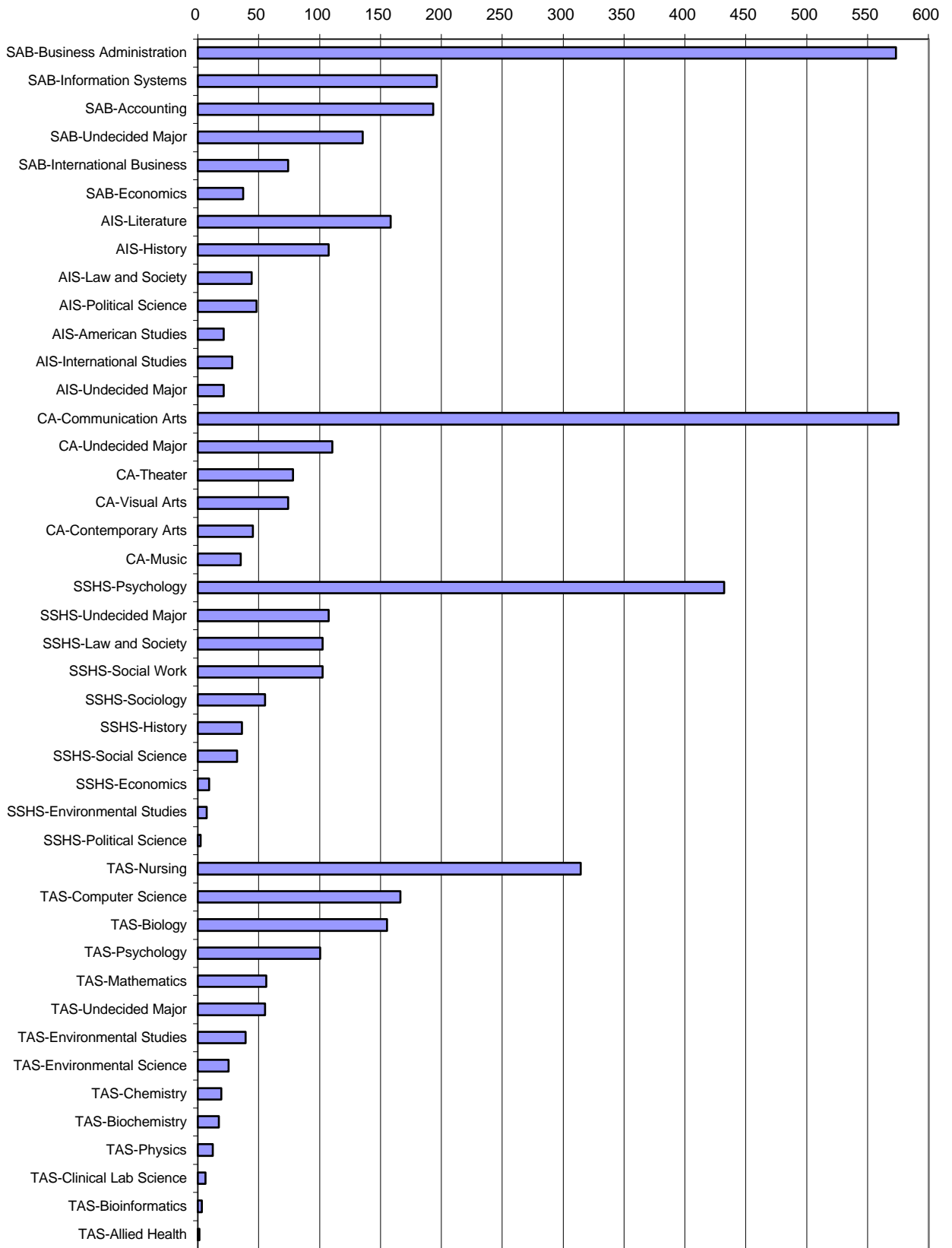

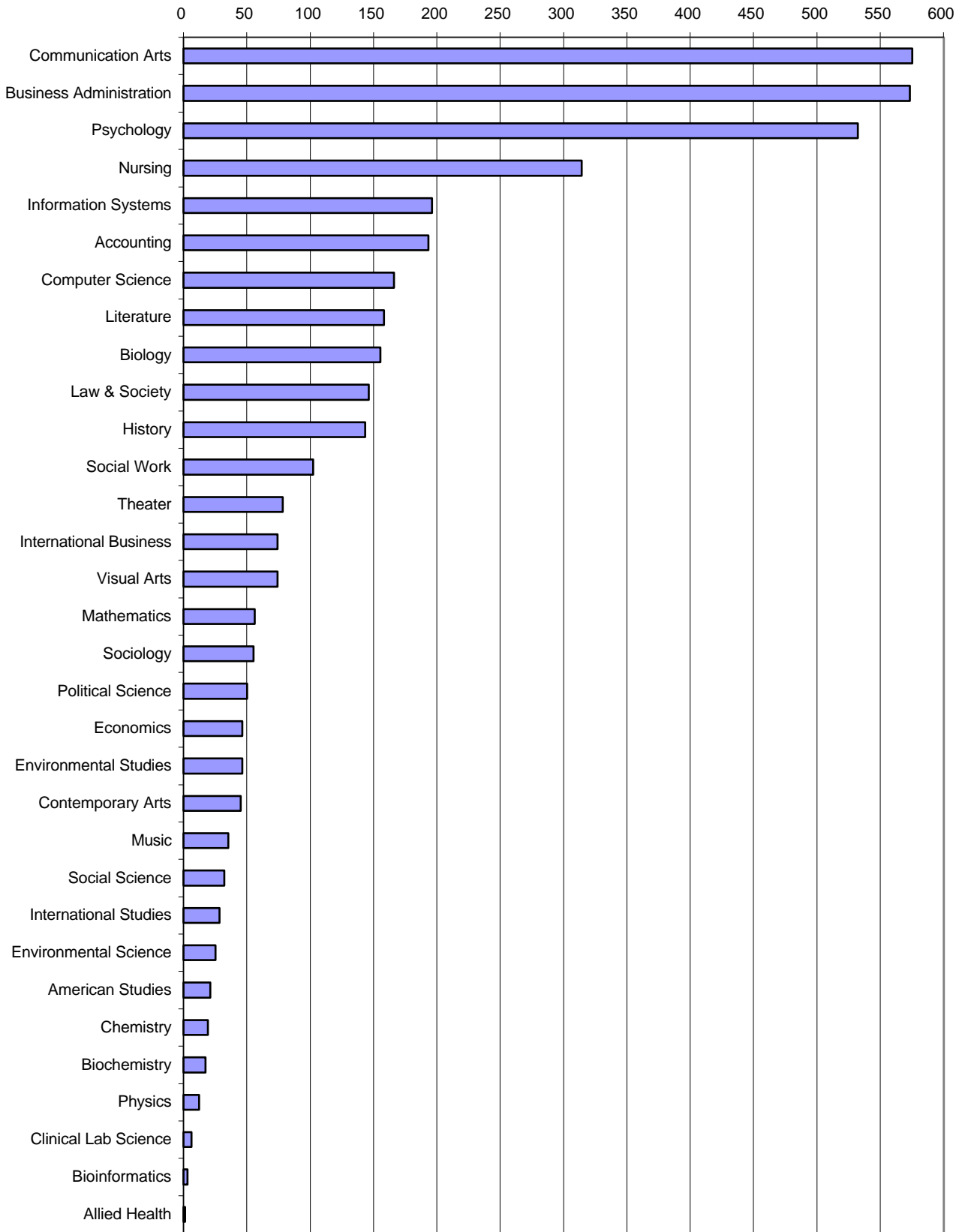

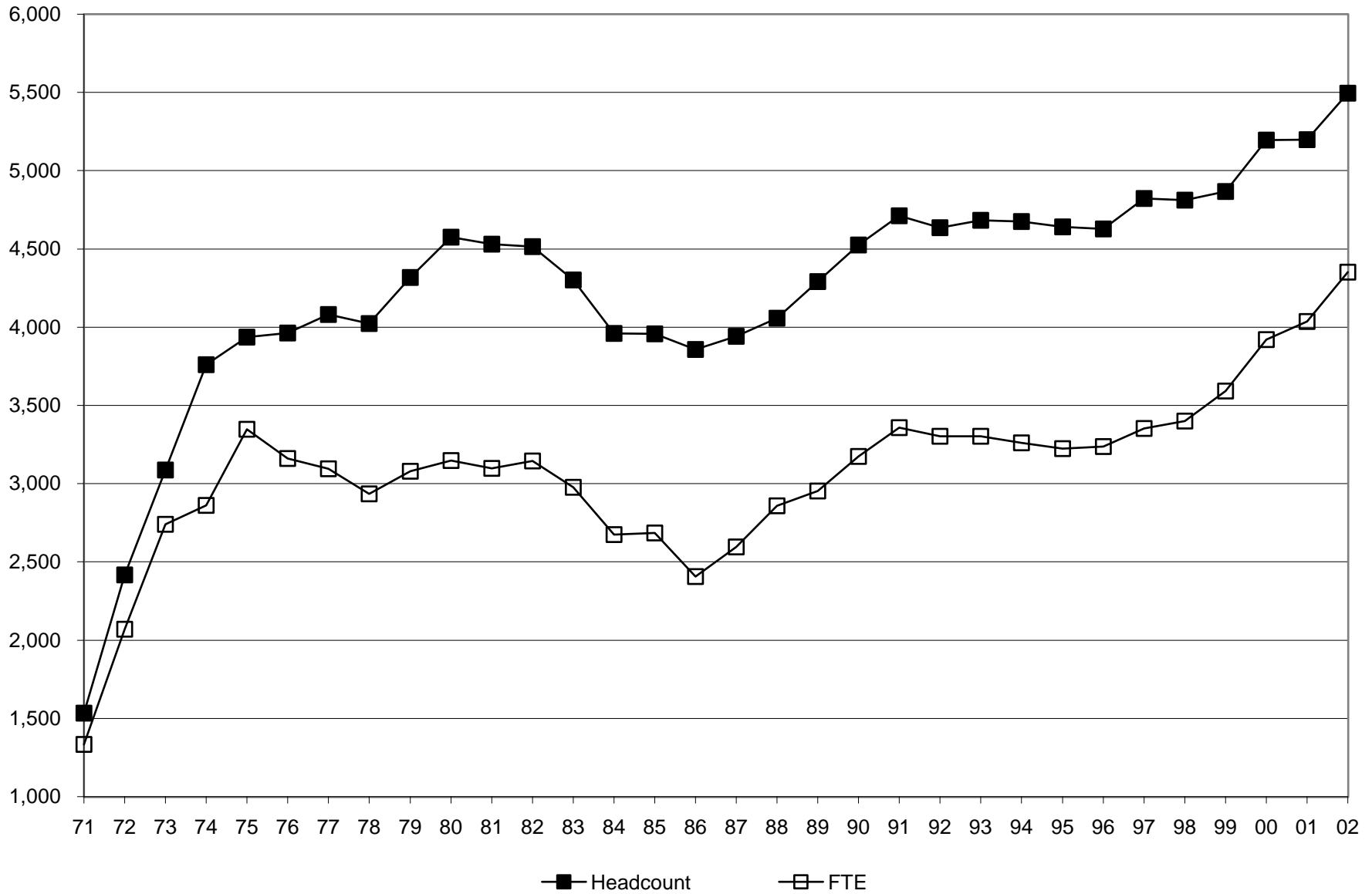

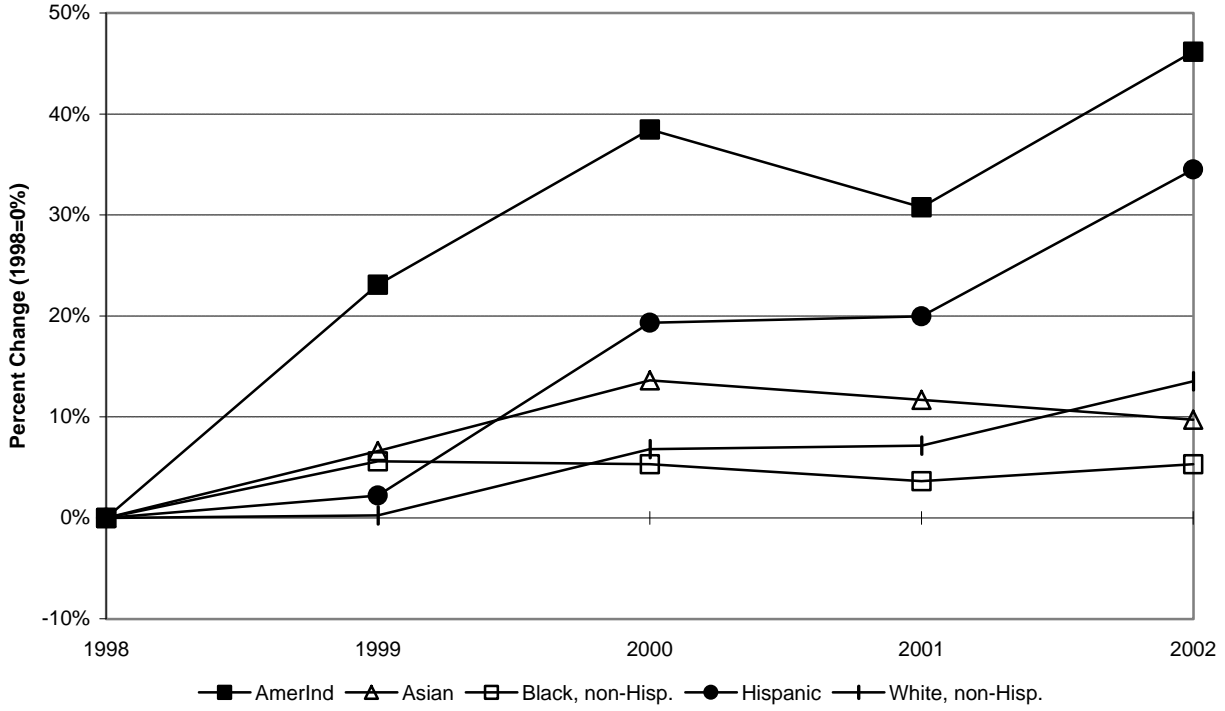

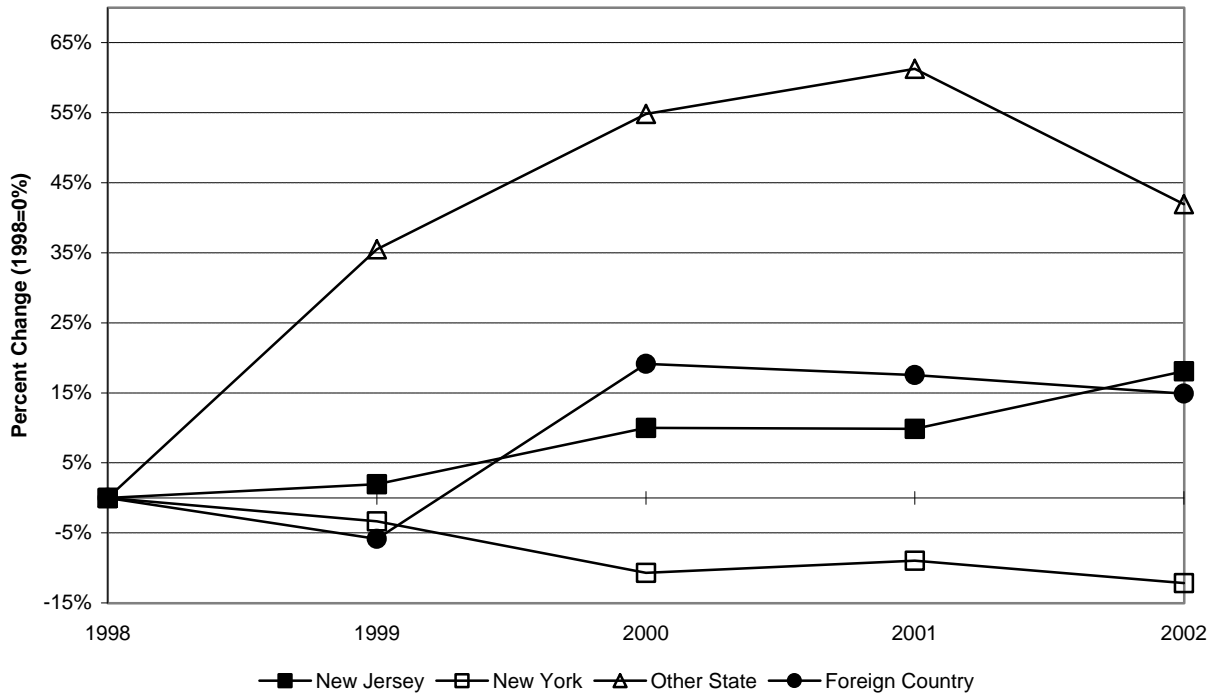

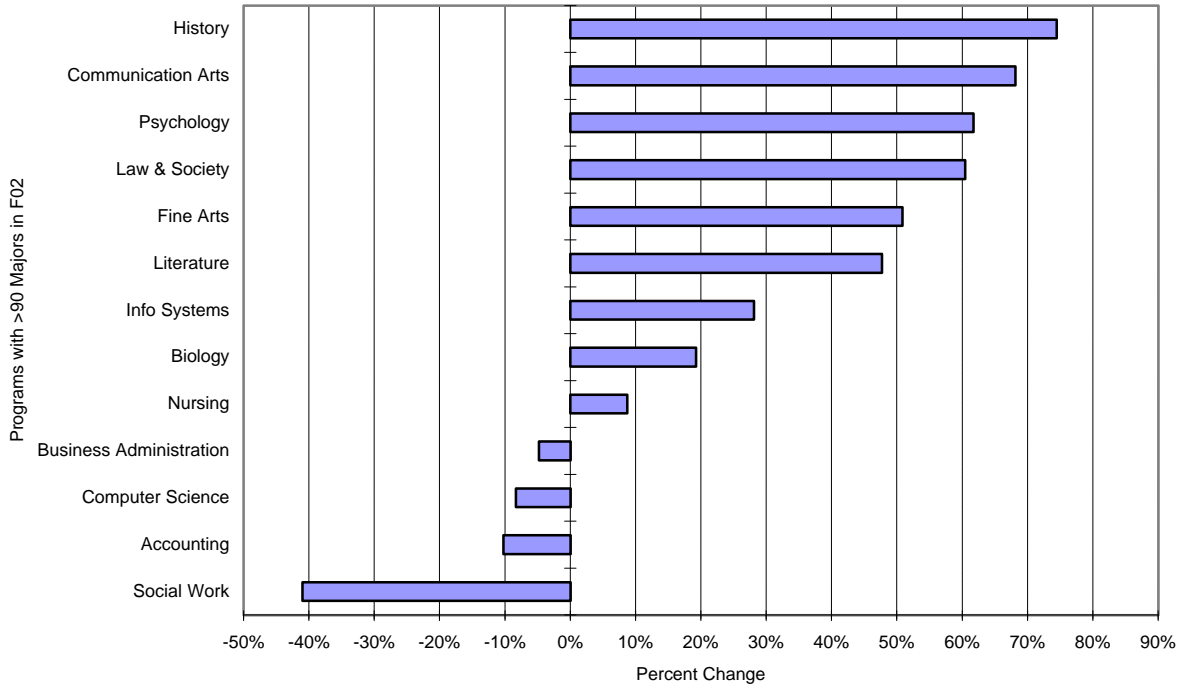

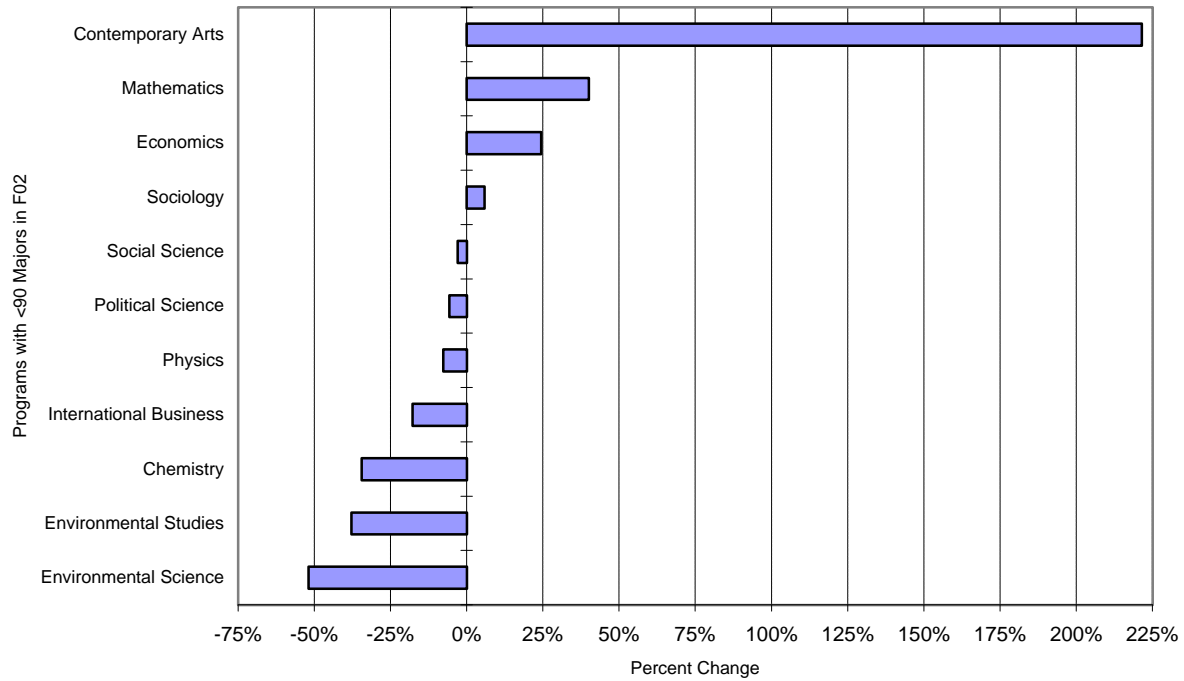

PERCENT CHANGE (F98 TO F02) IN ENROLLMENT BY PRIMARY MAJOR

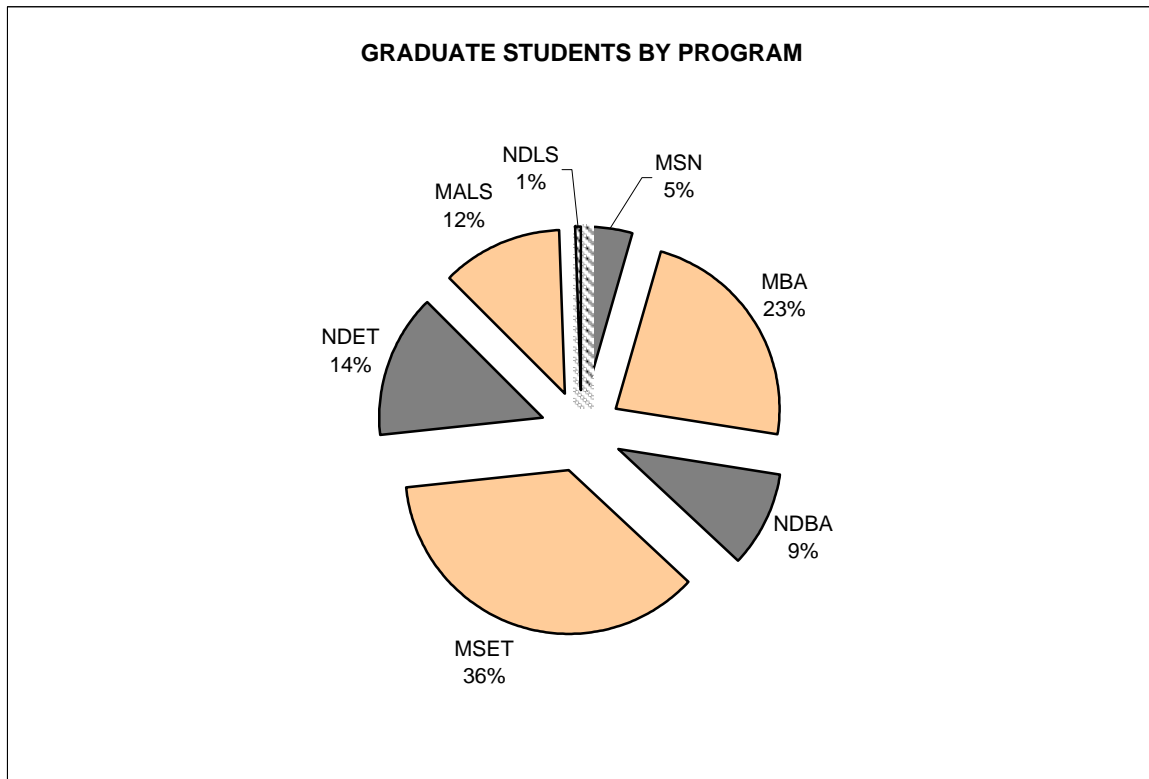
