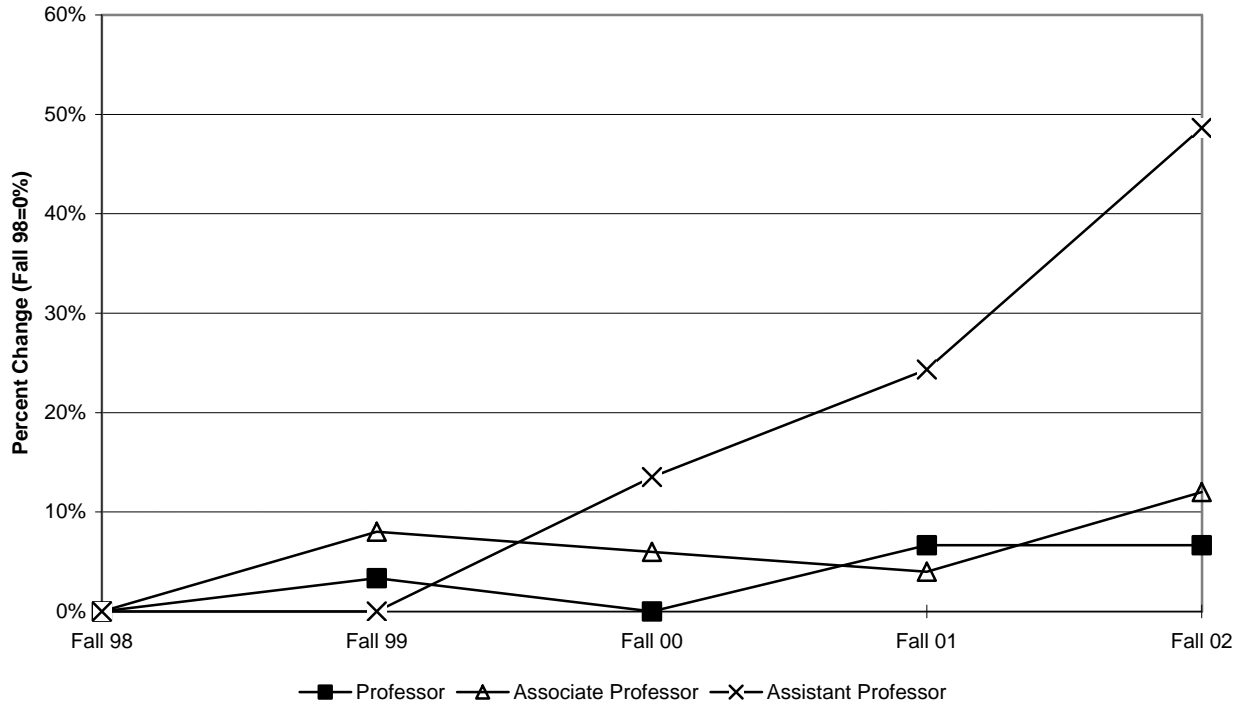

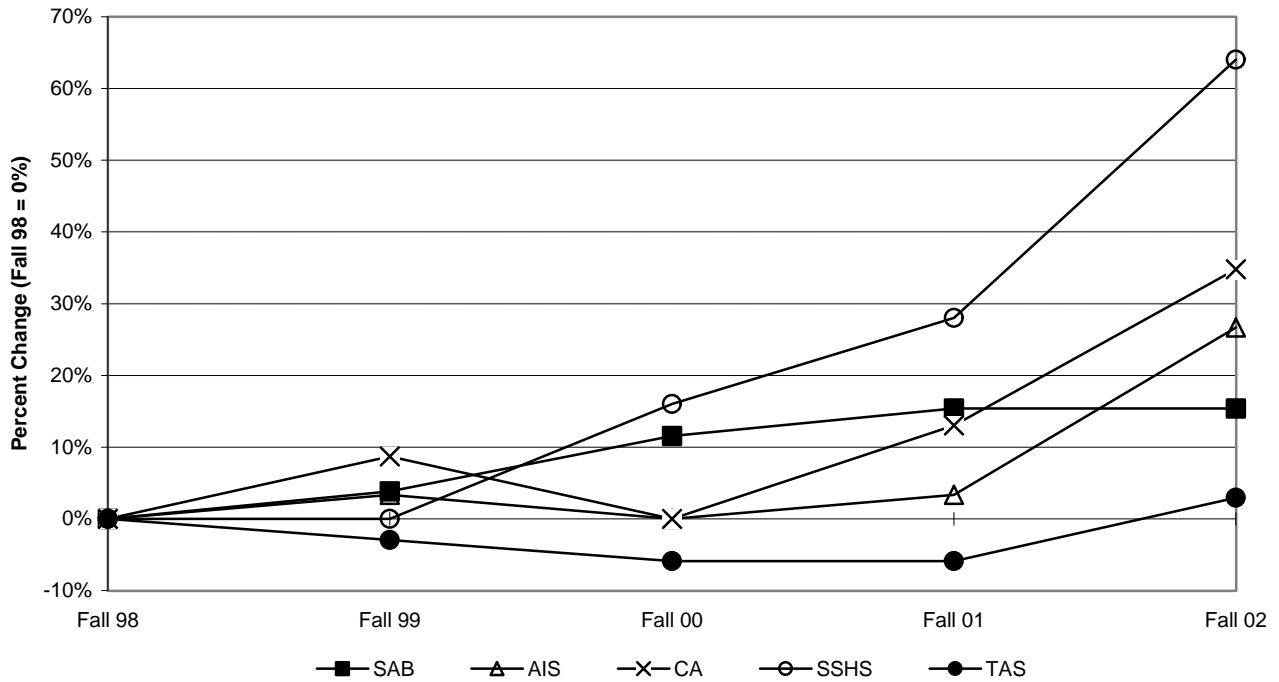
CUMULATIVE PERCENT CHANGE IN FACULTY BY RANK

(includes schl/div with 10 or more faculty in each of 5 years)



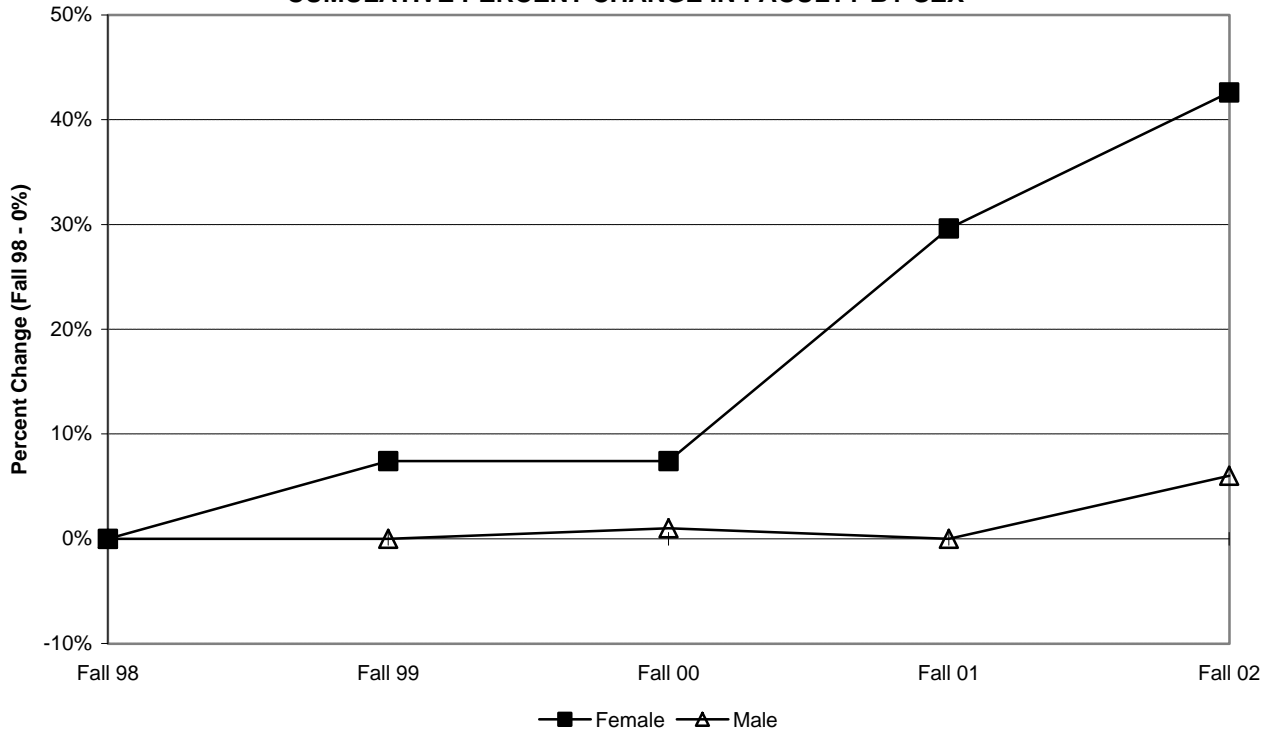

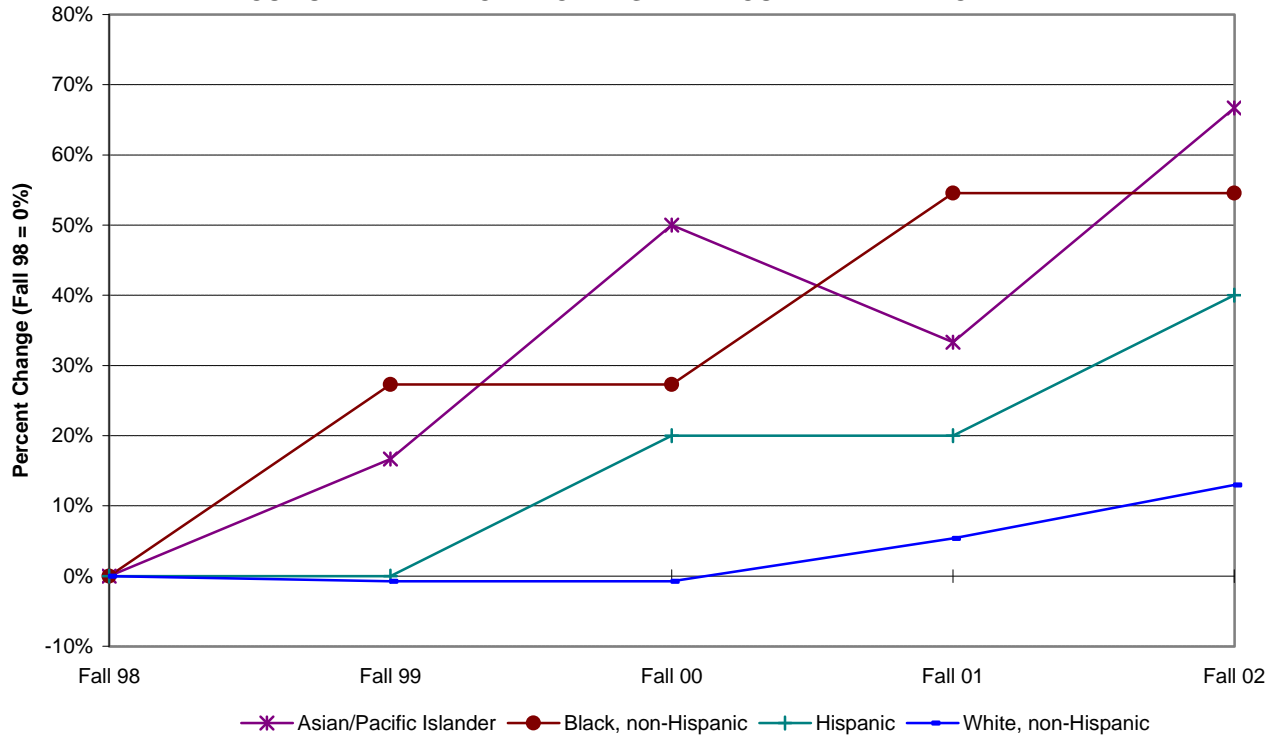

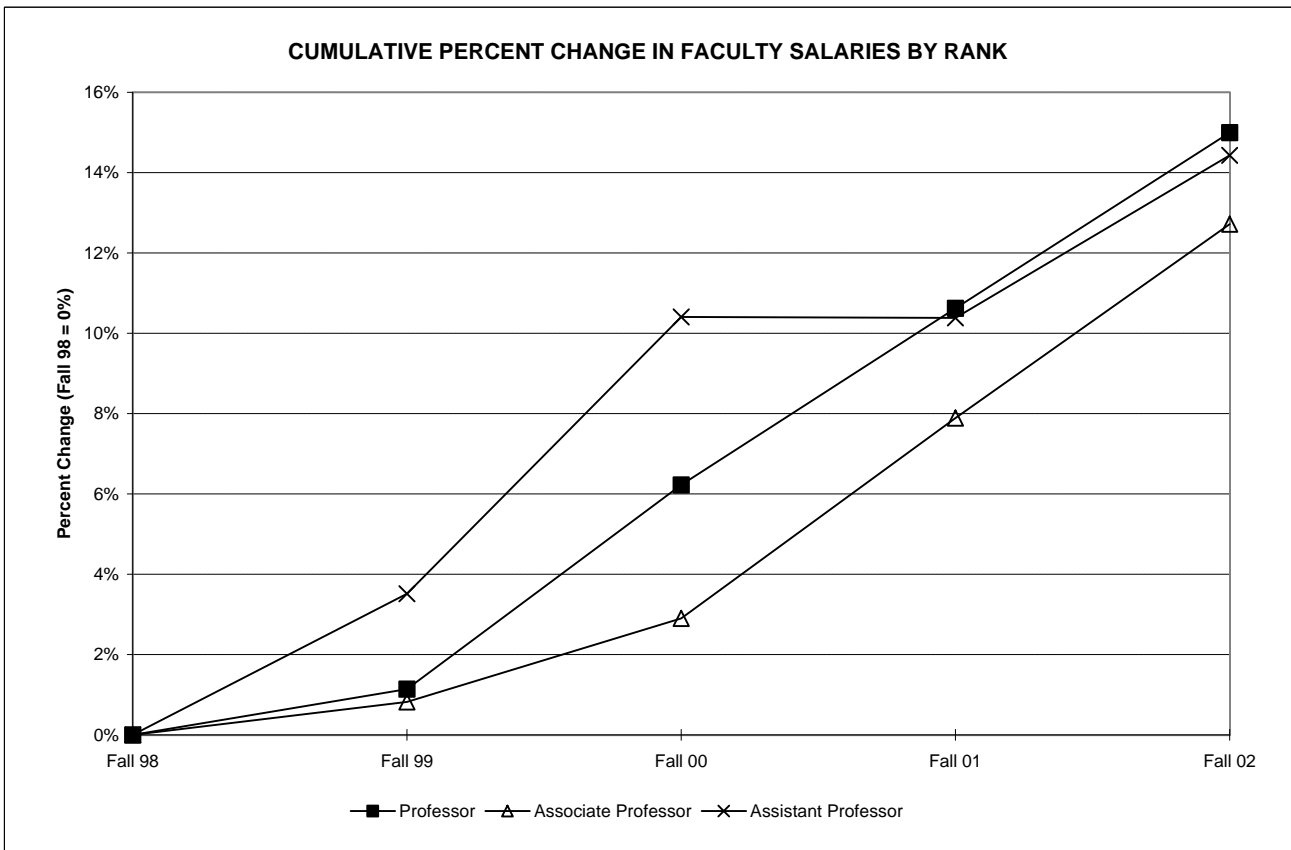

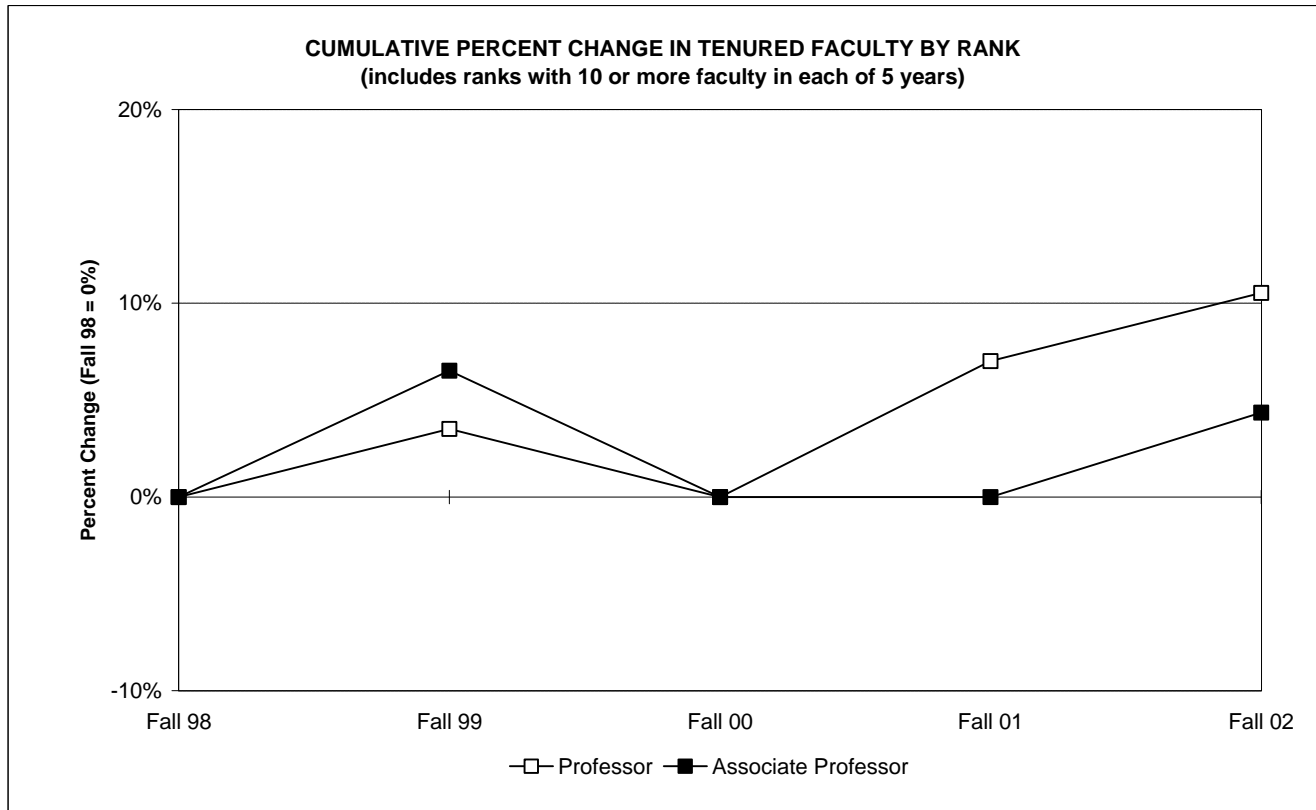

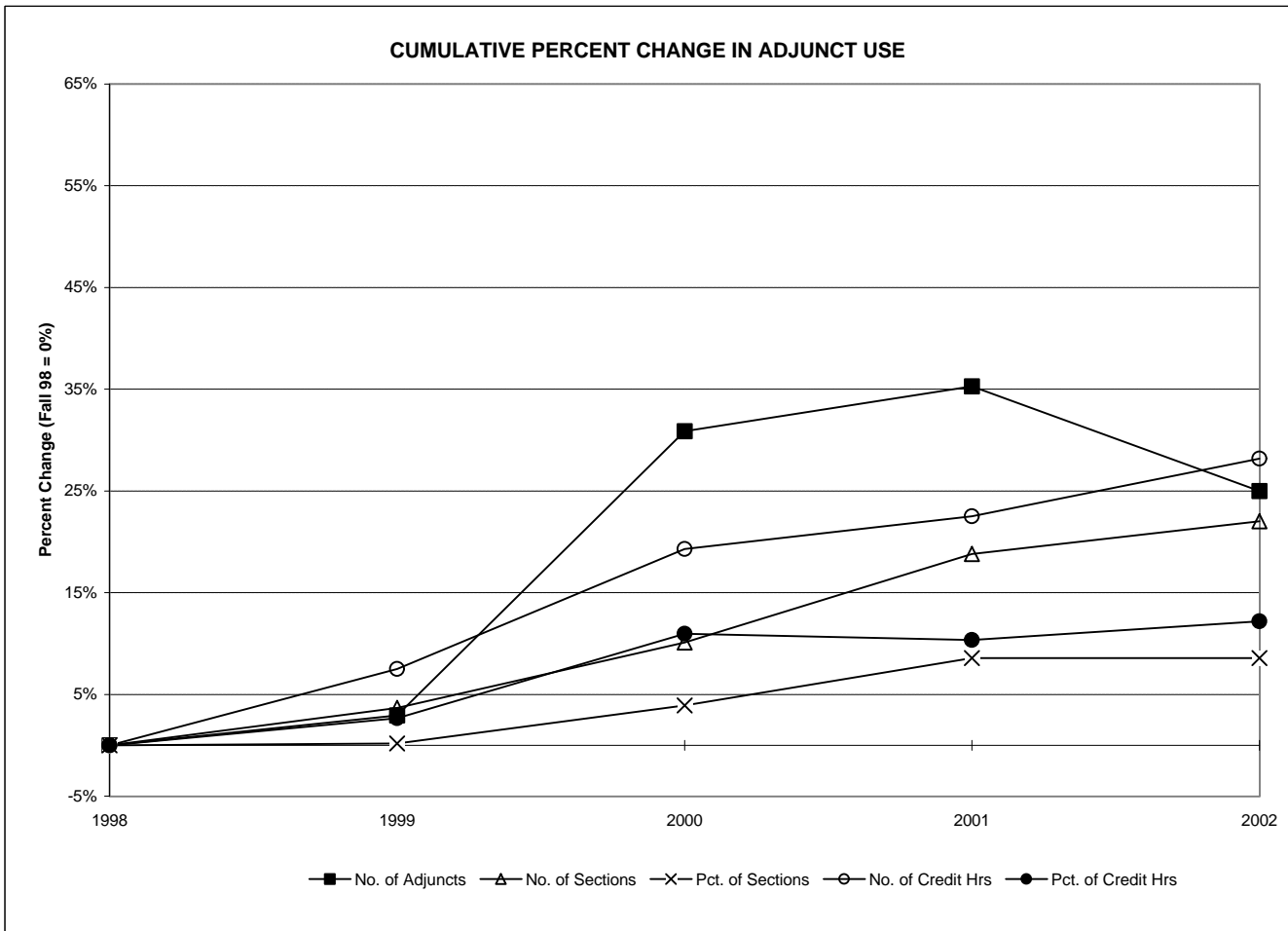
