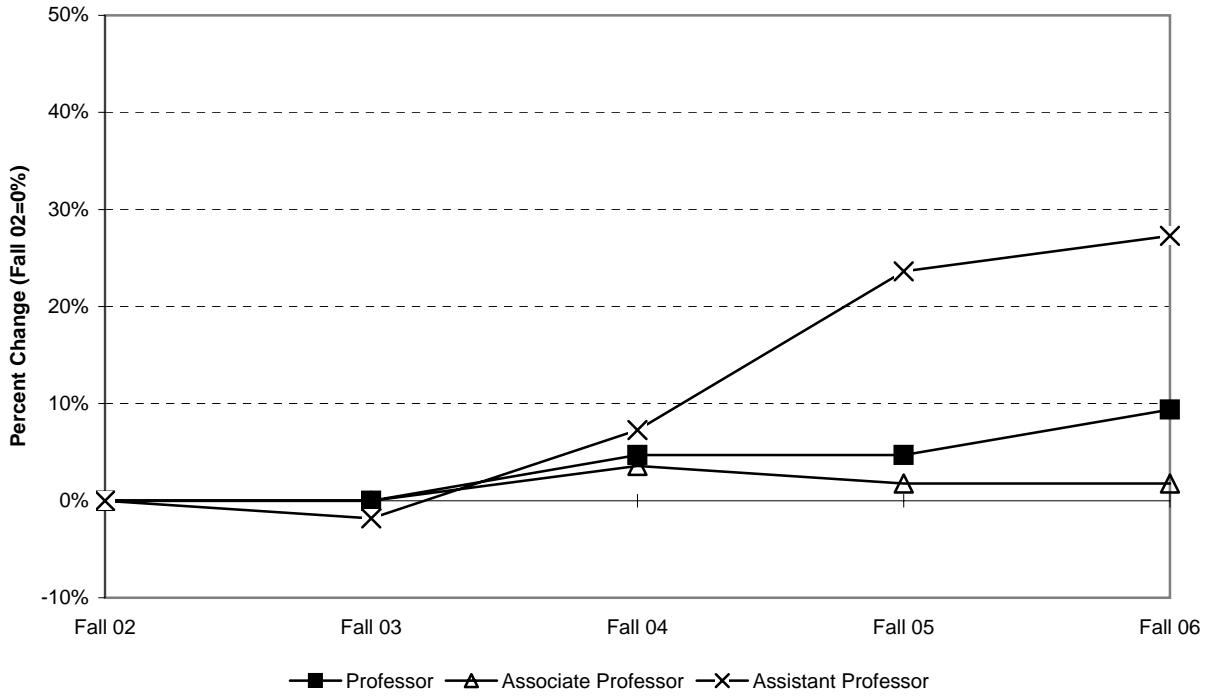

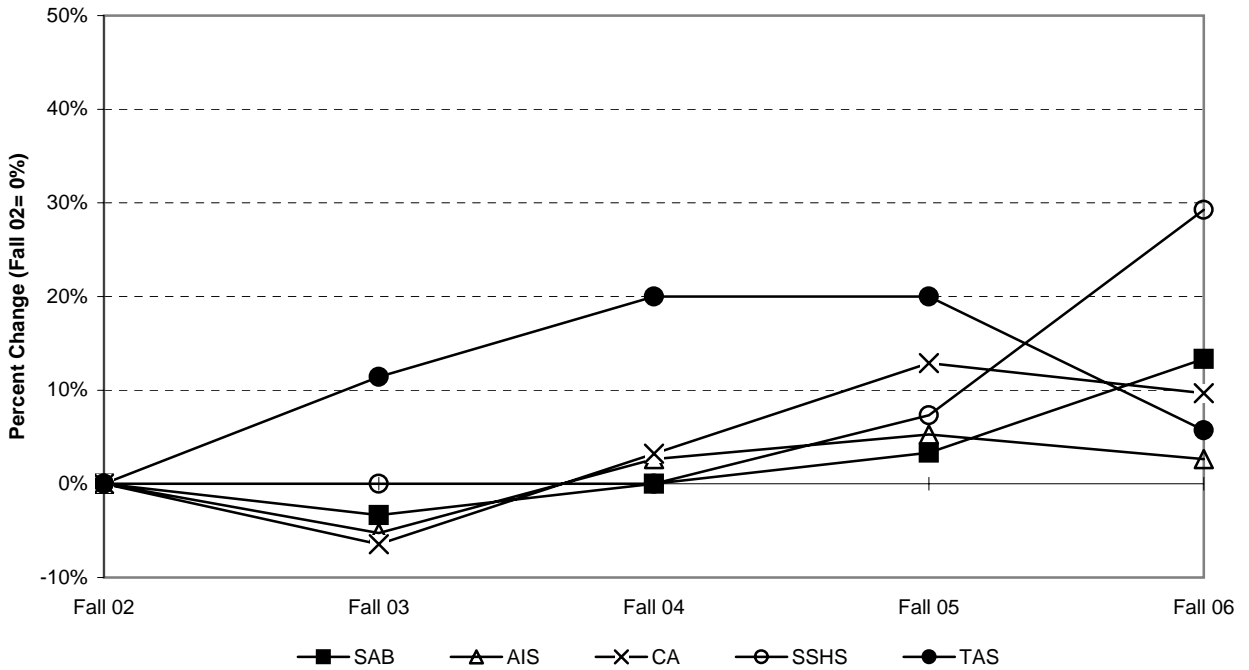

 (includes schl/div with 10 or more faculty in each of 5 years)

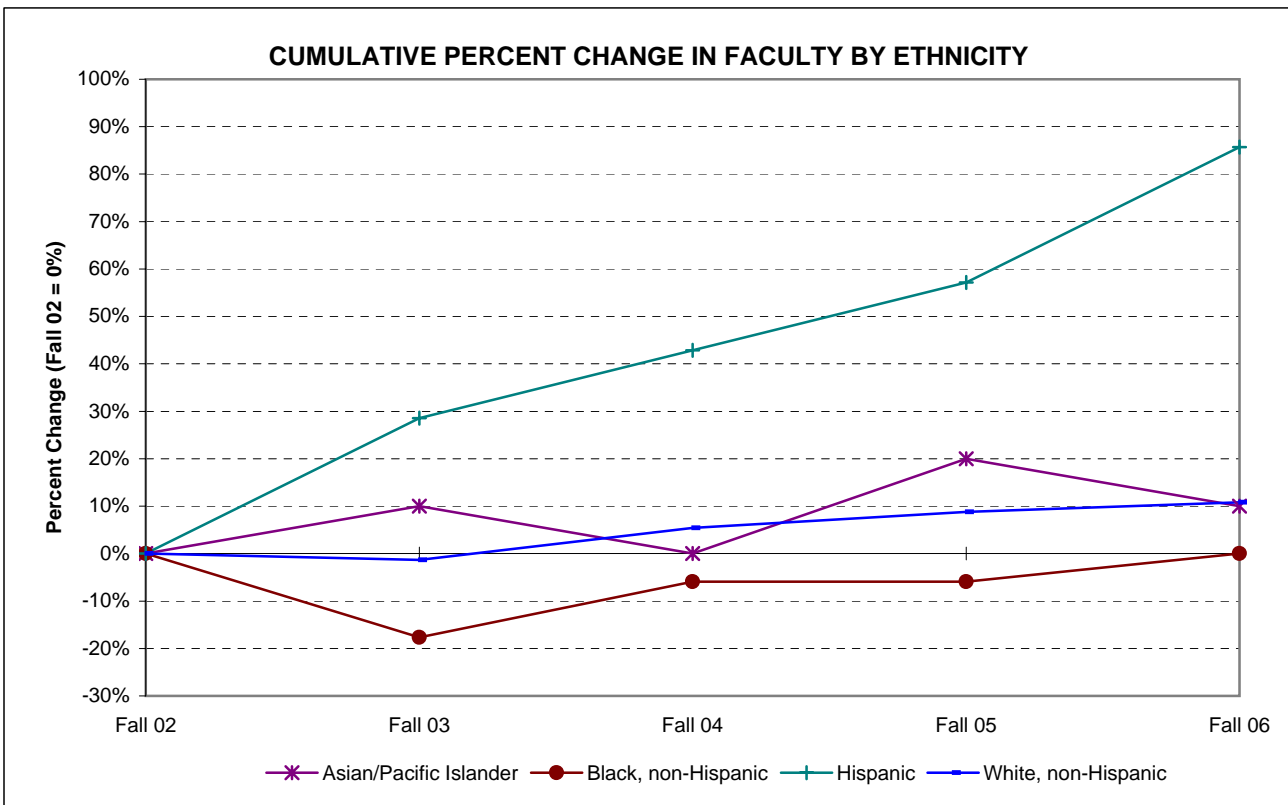
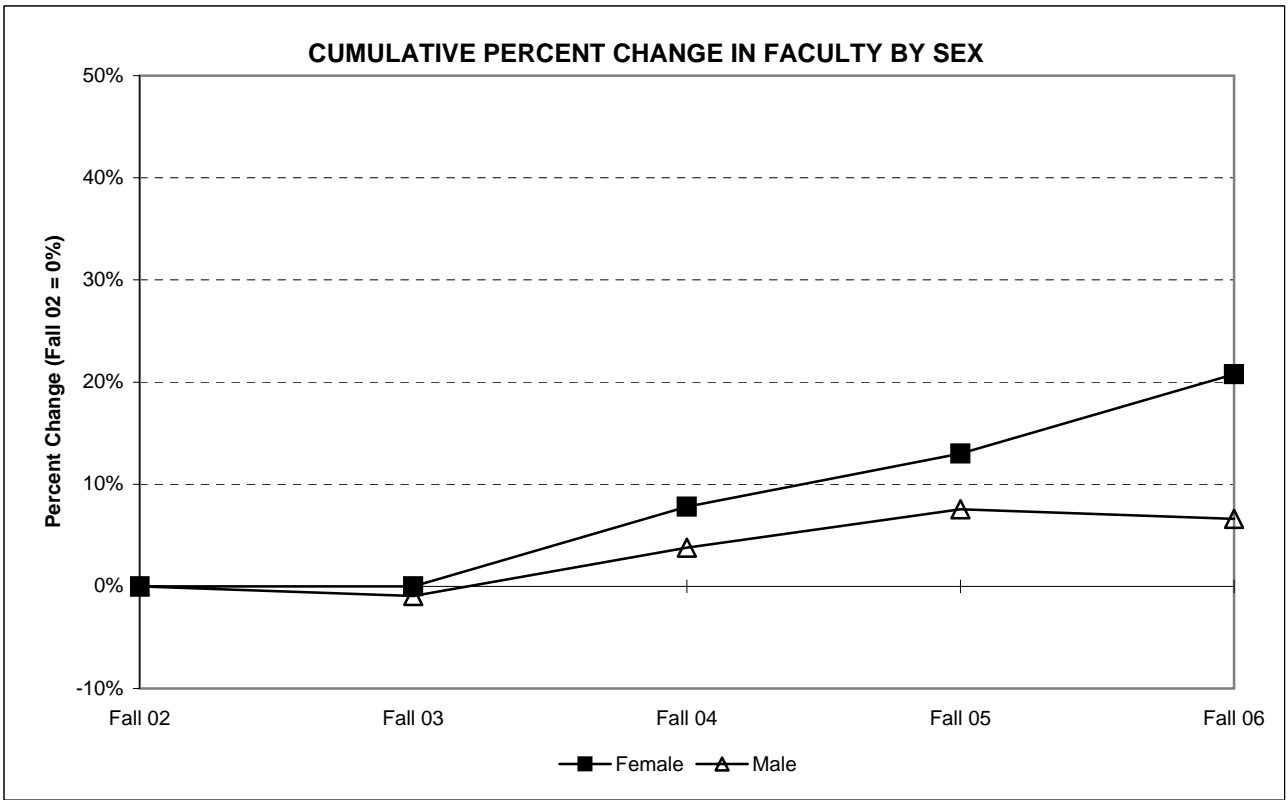

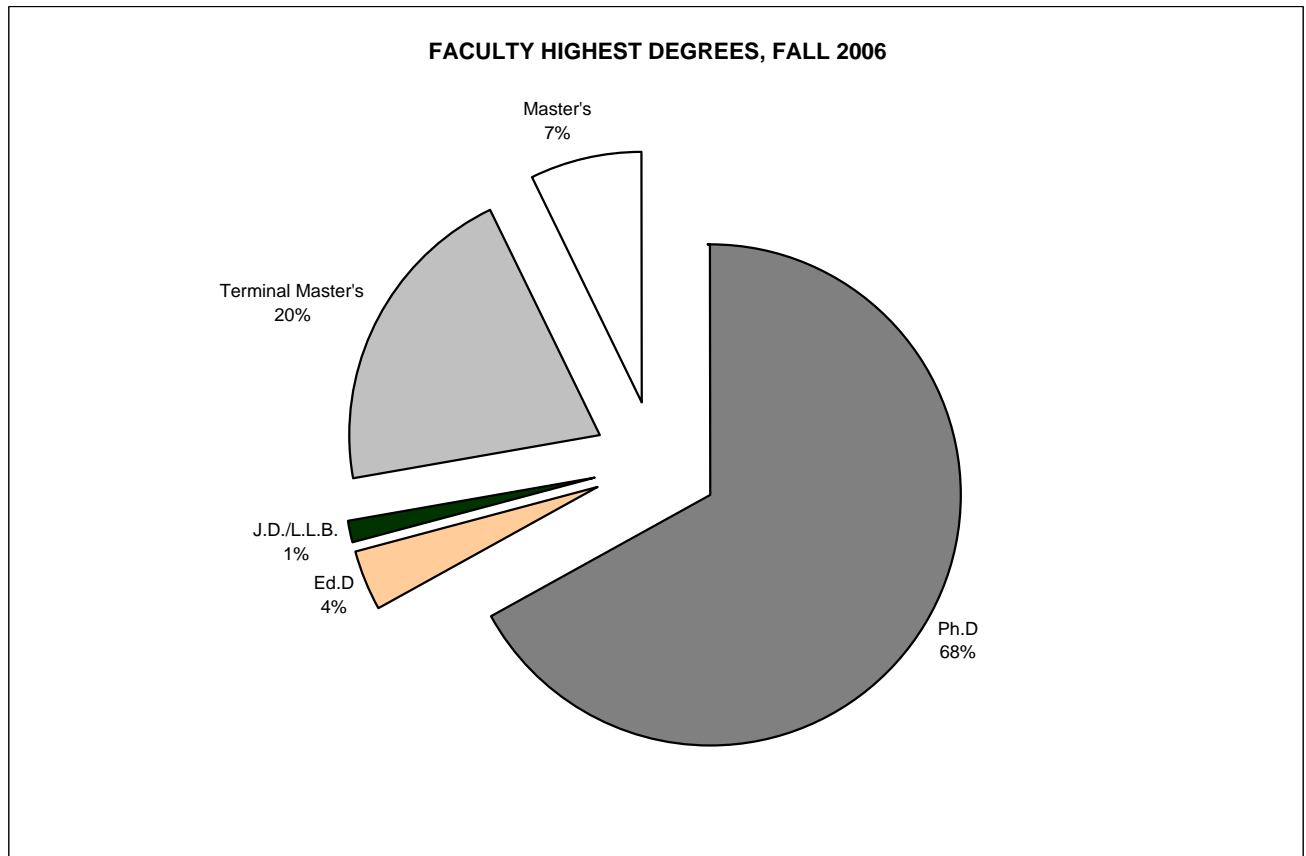

**FACULTY DEGREES BY SEX, FALL 2006**

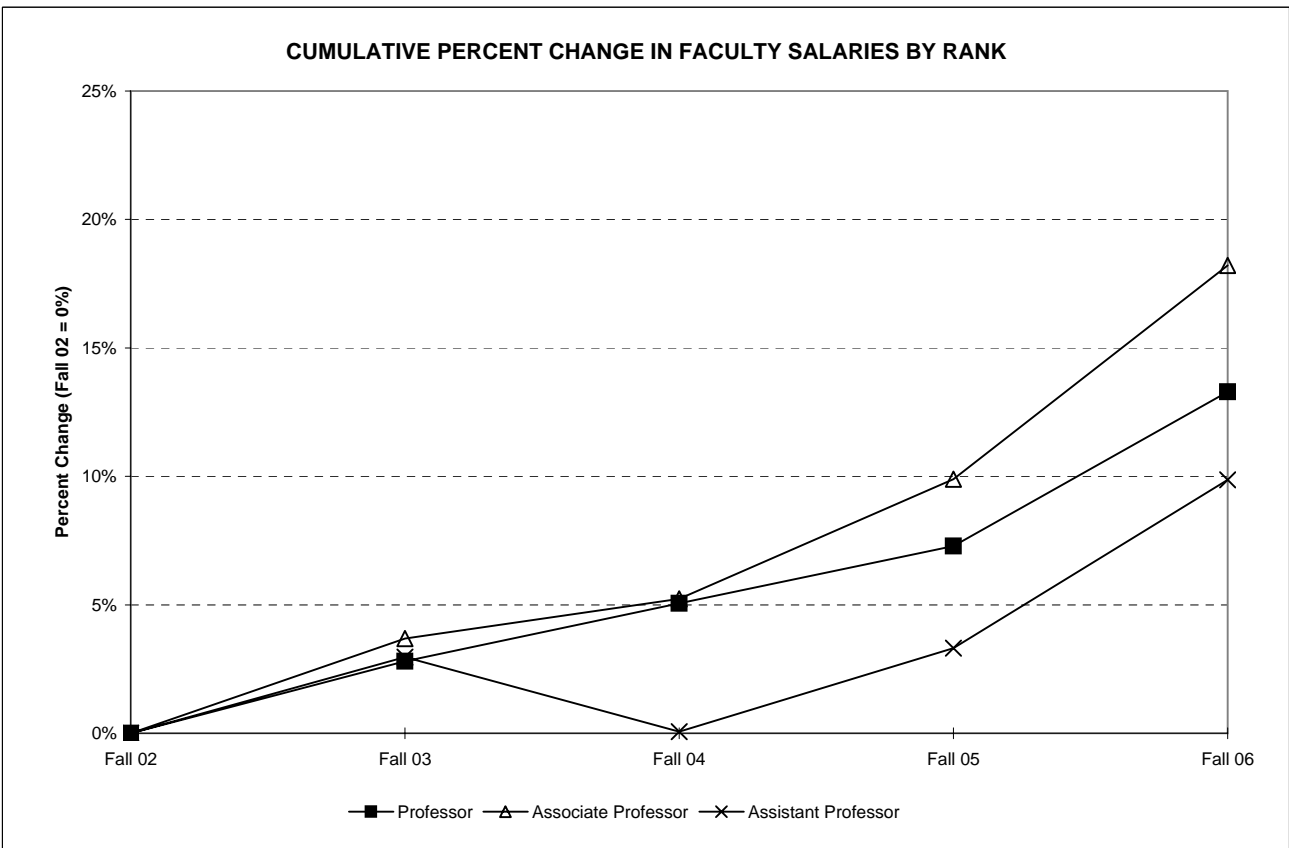

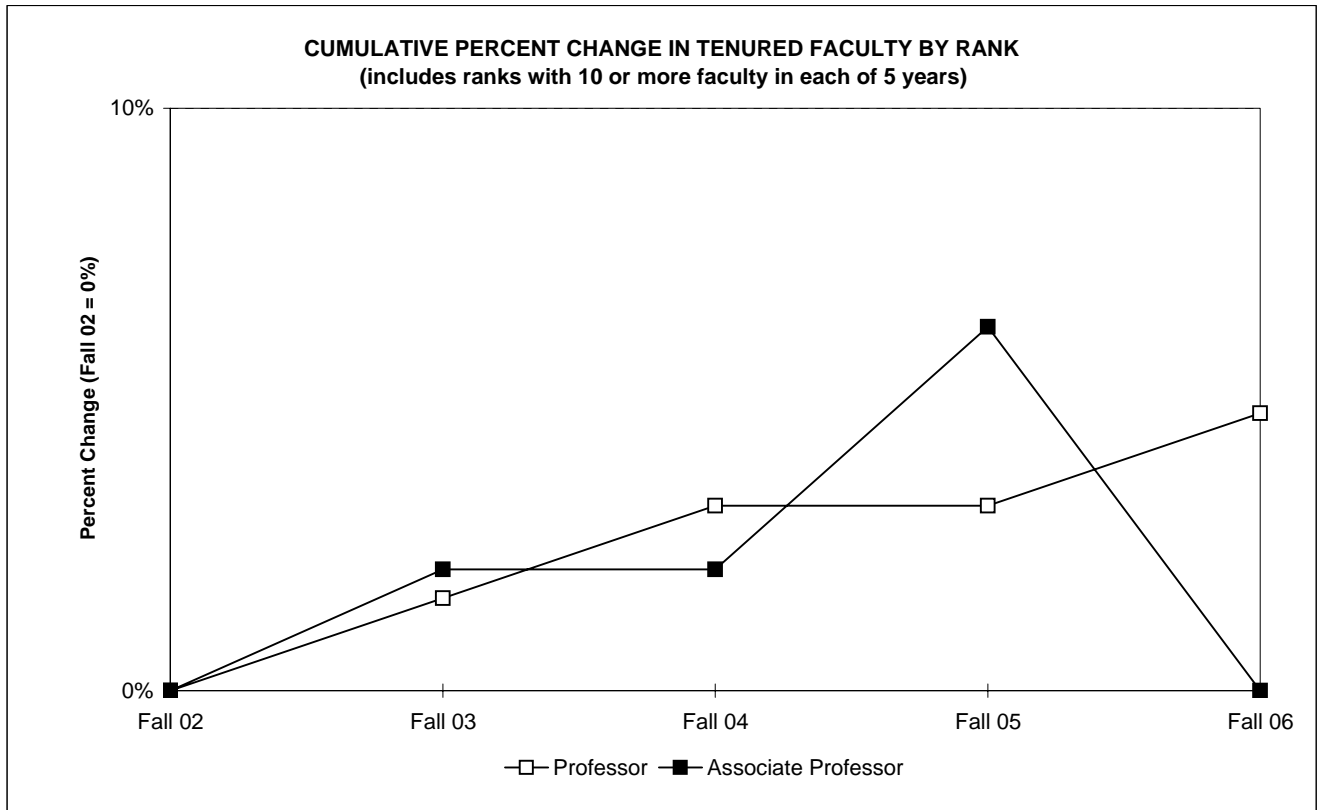
