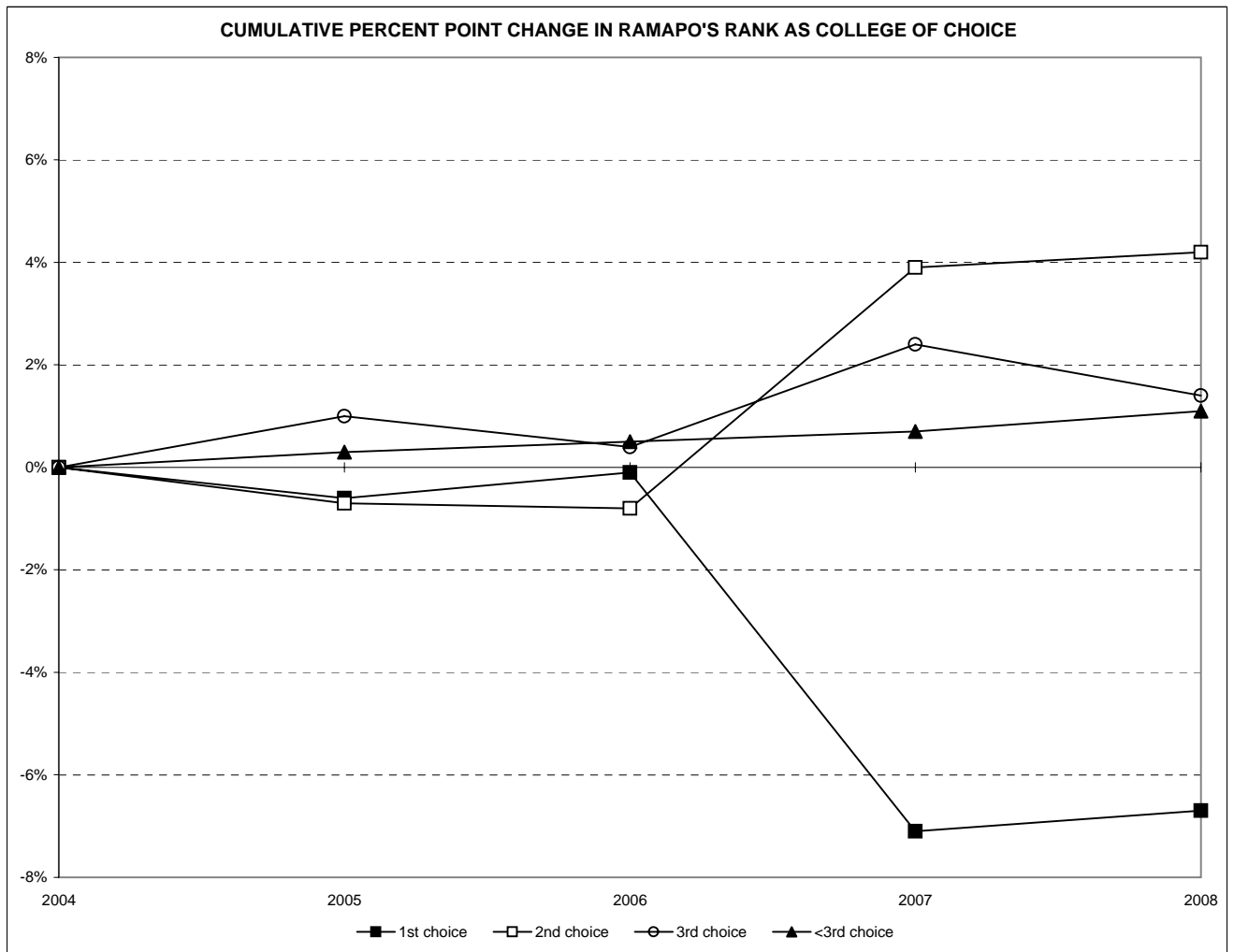

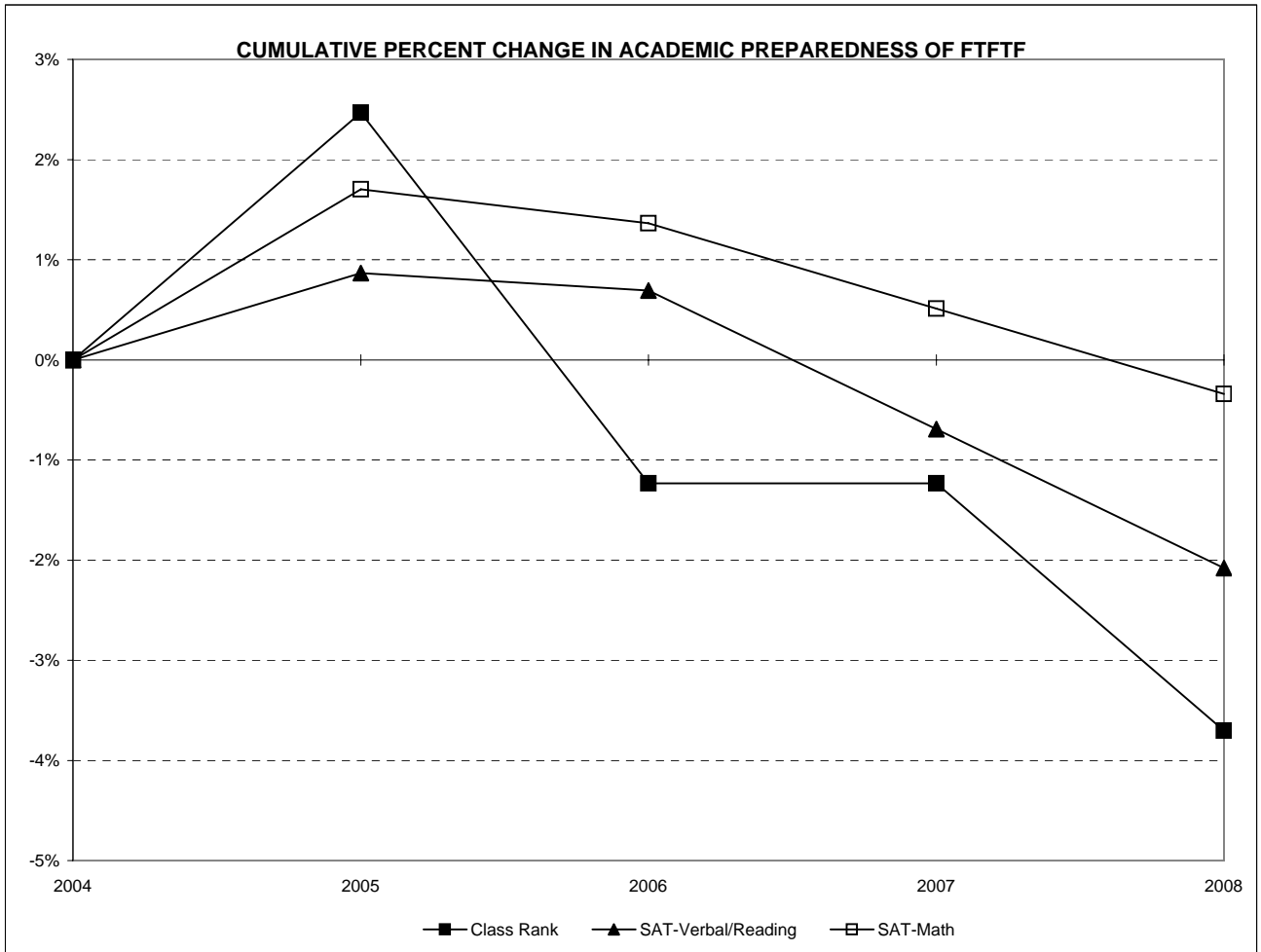

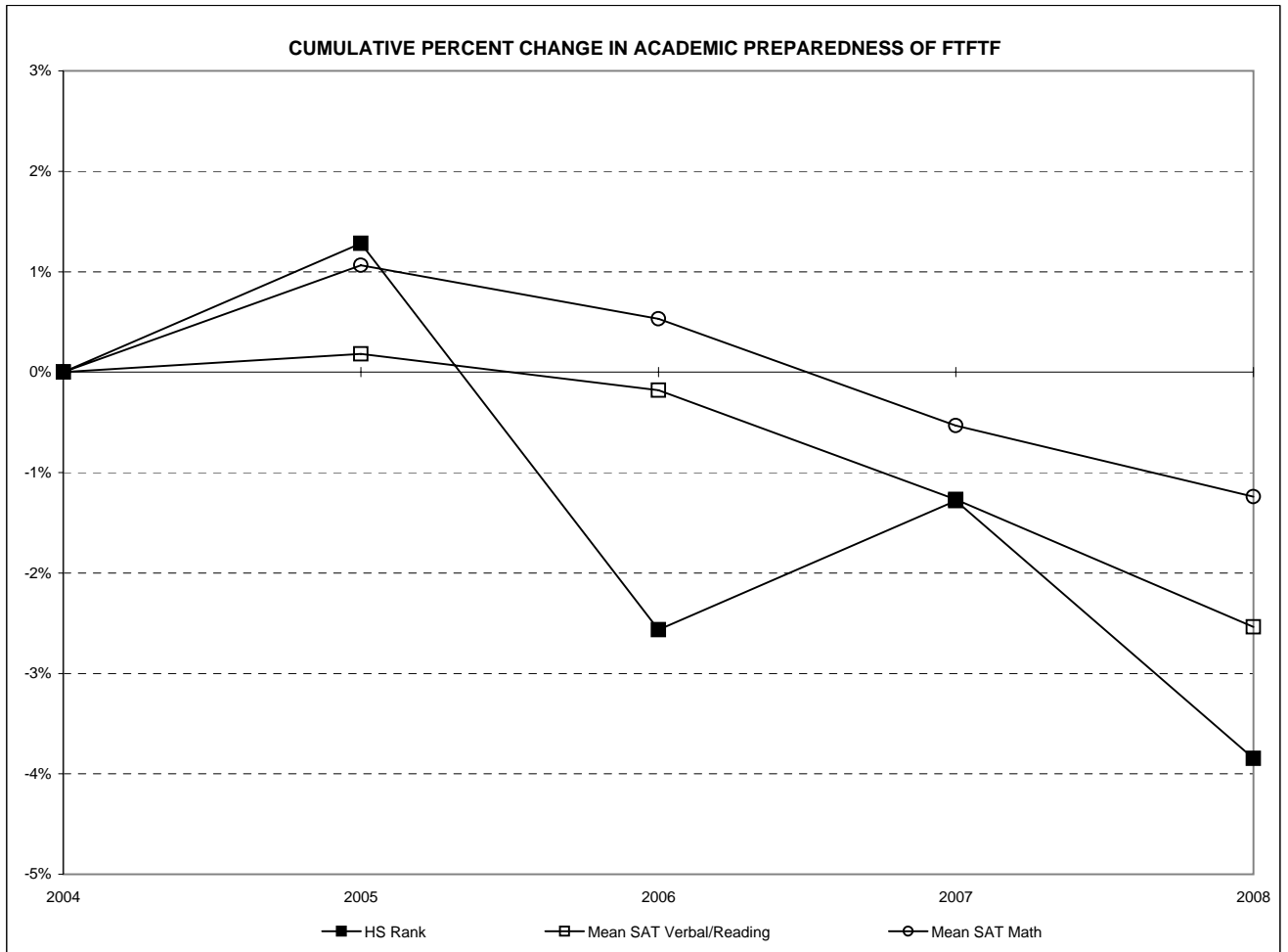

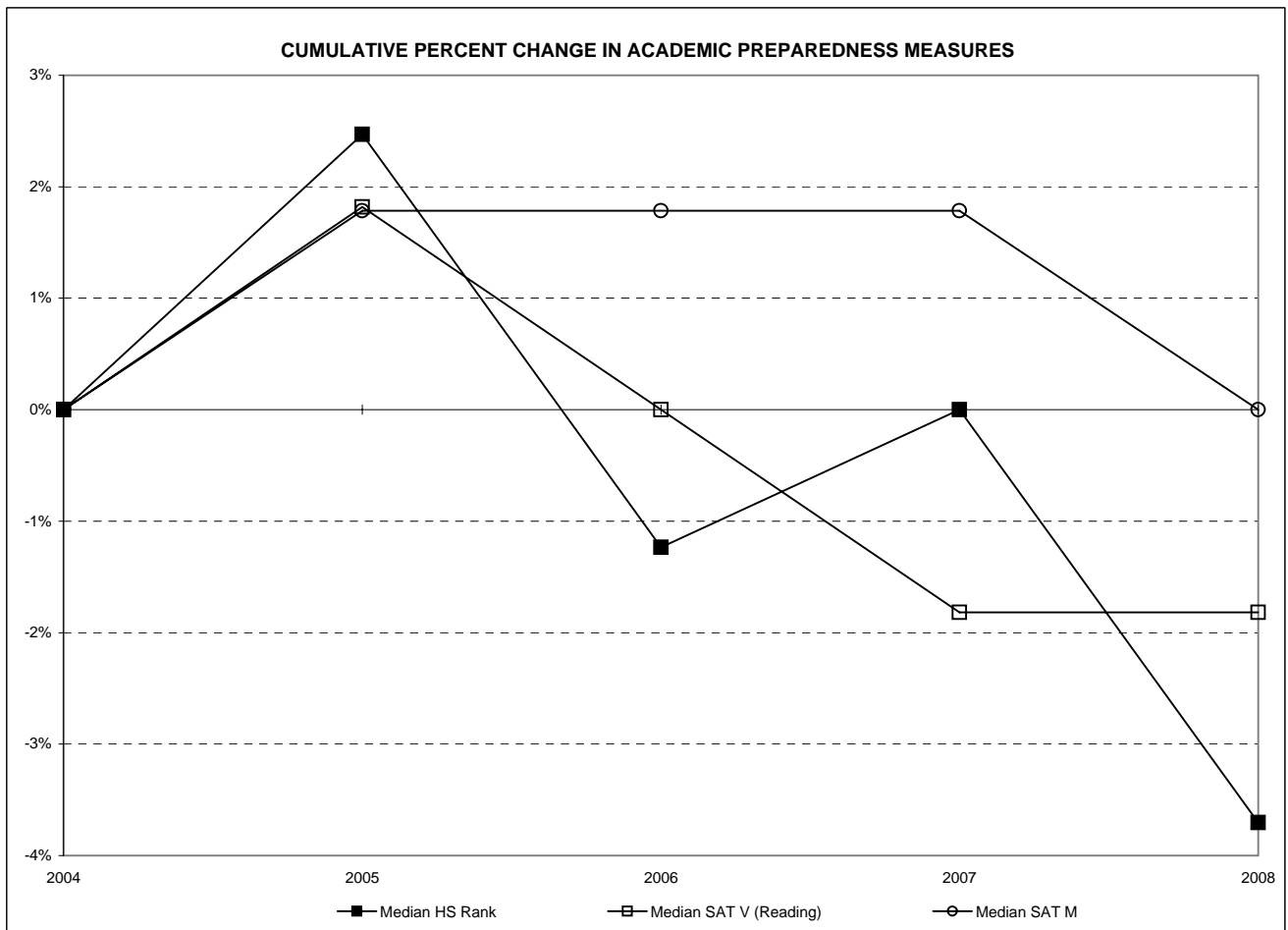

[3] In 2008, the cut scores used to determine proficiency in reading were changed. The reading cut score was raised from 71 to 76.

[4] In 2008, the minimum proficient SAT Verbal/Reading score for the freshmen placement test performance in Essay and Sentence Skills was raised from a minimum of 530 to 550.

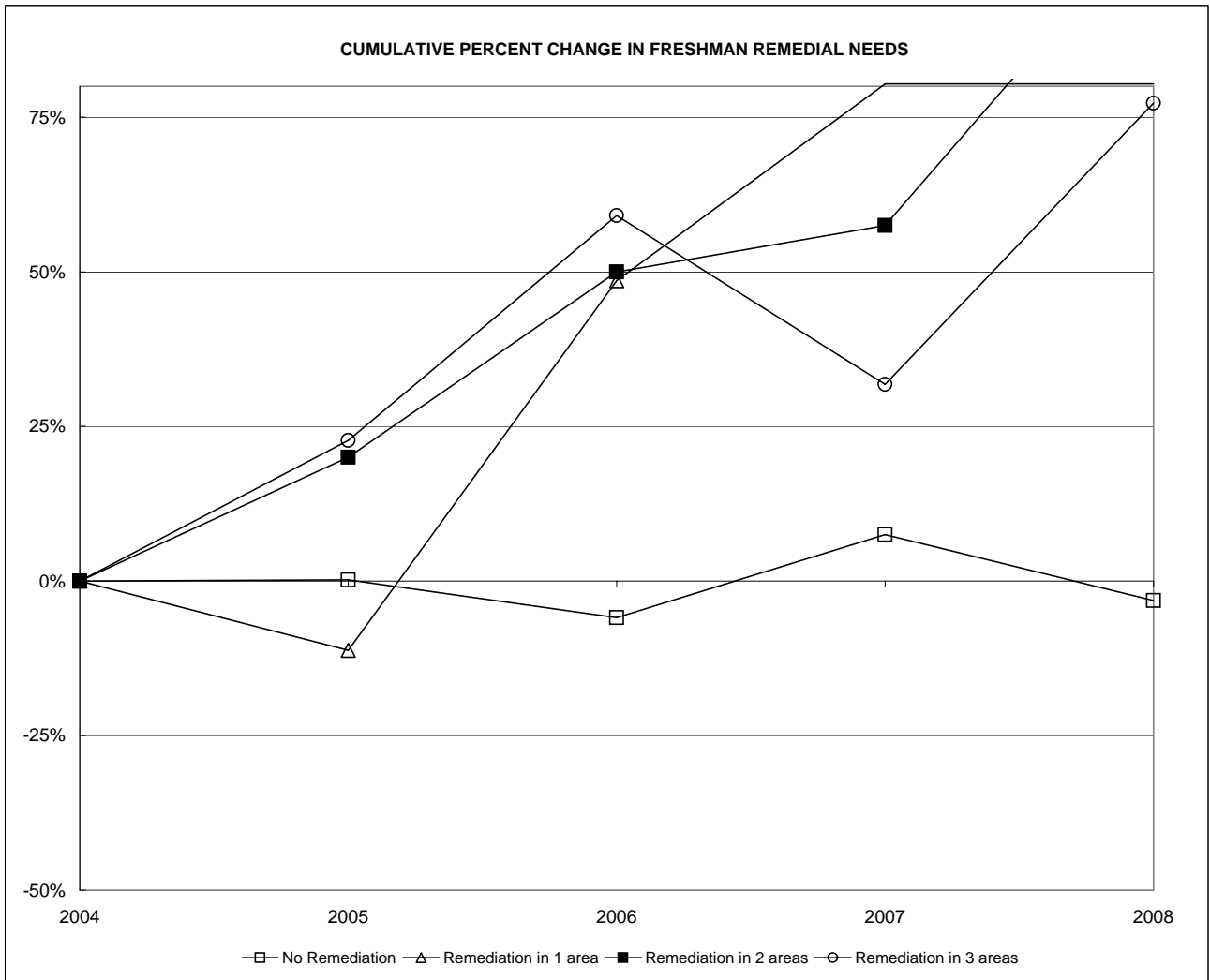

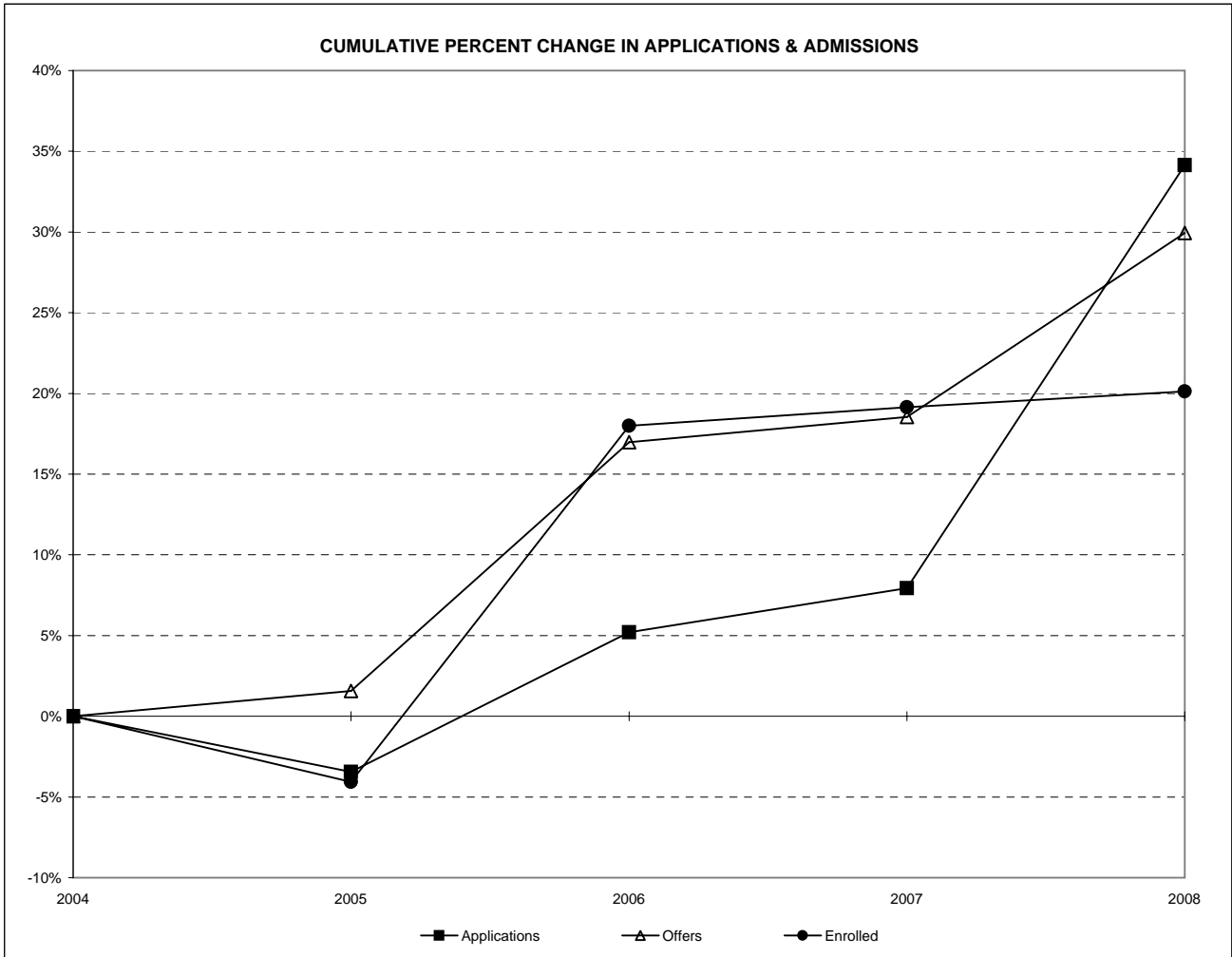

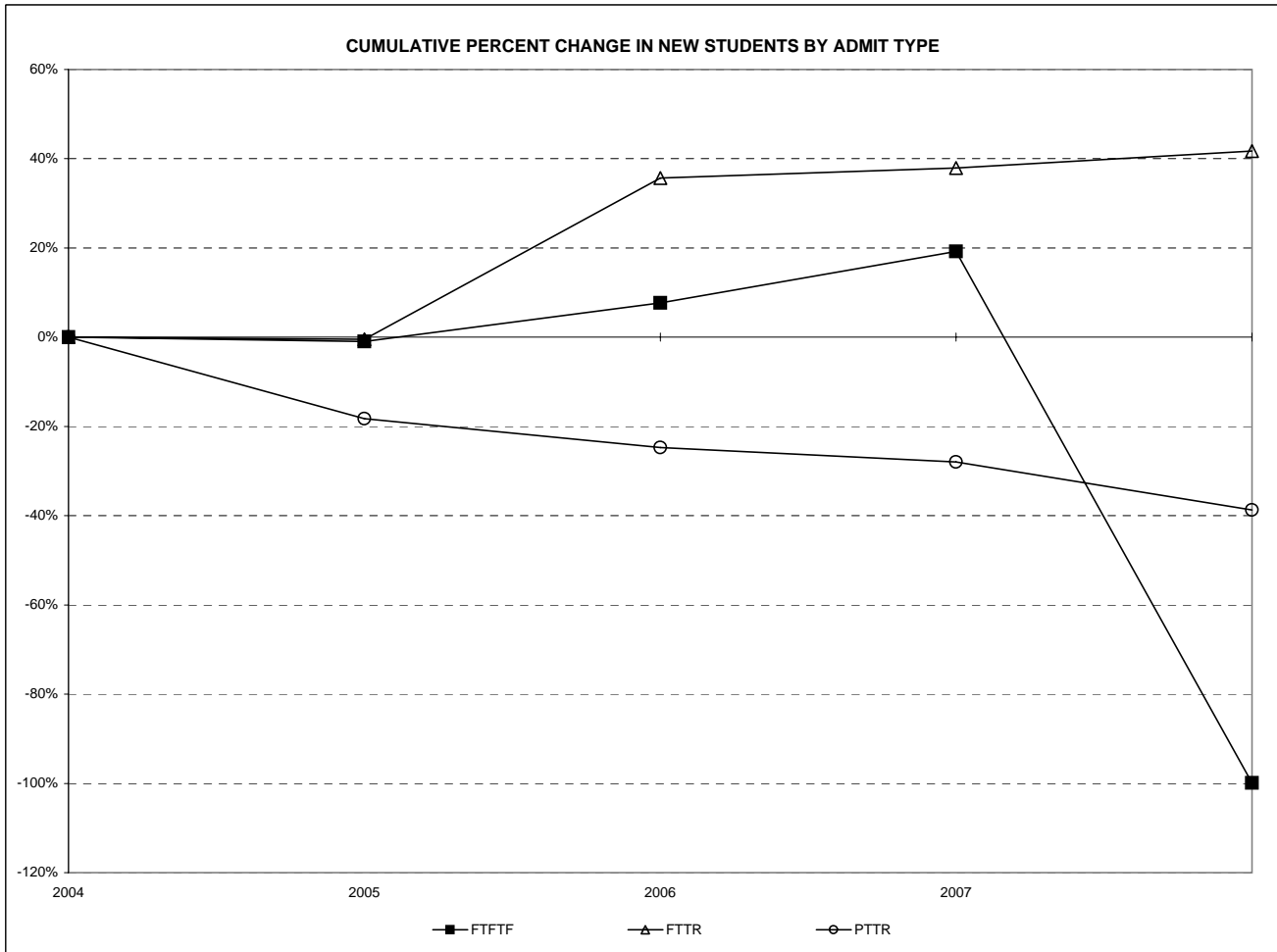
