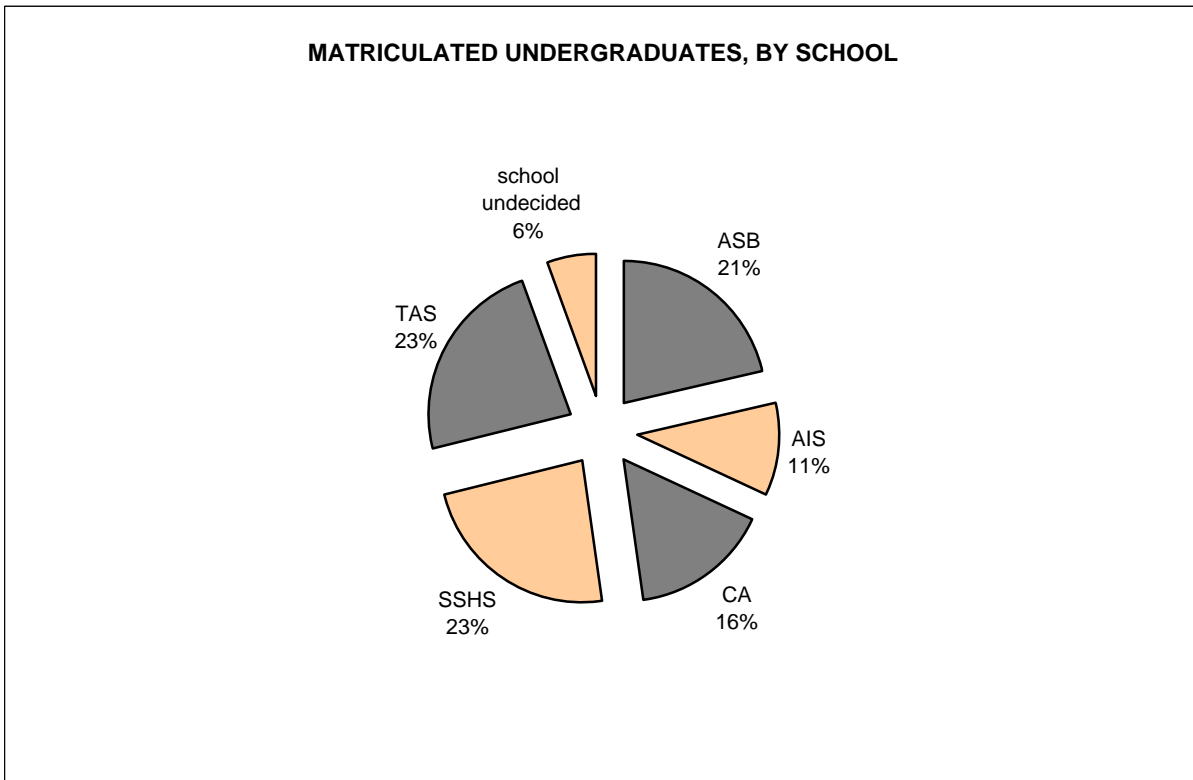

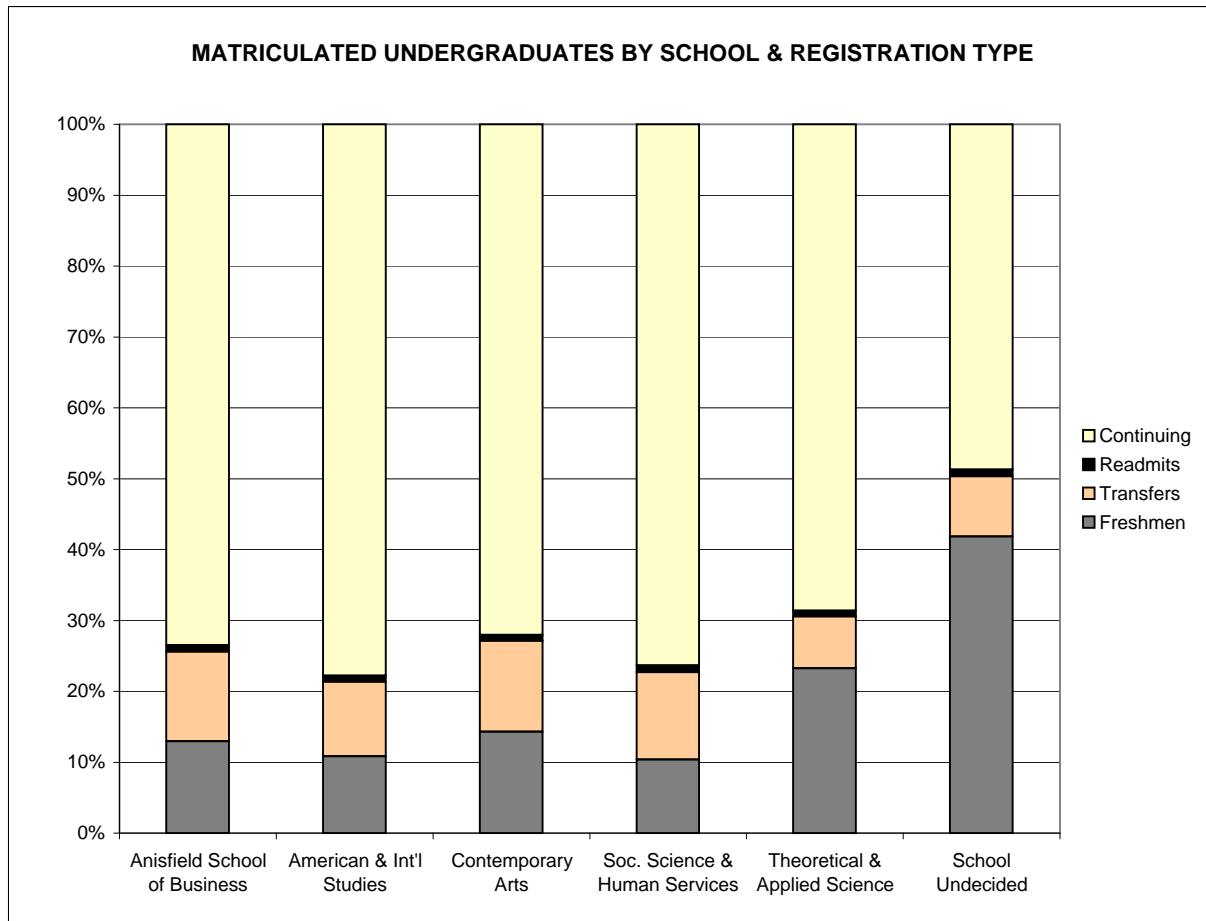

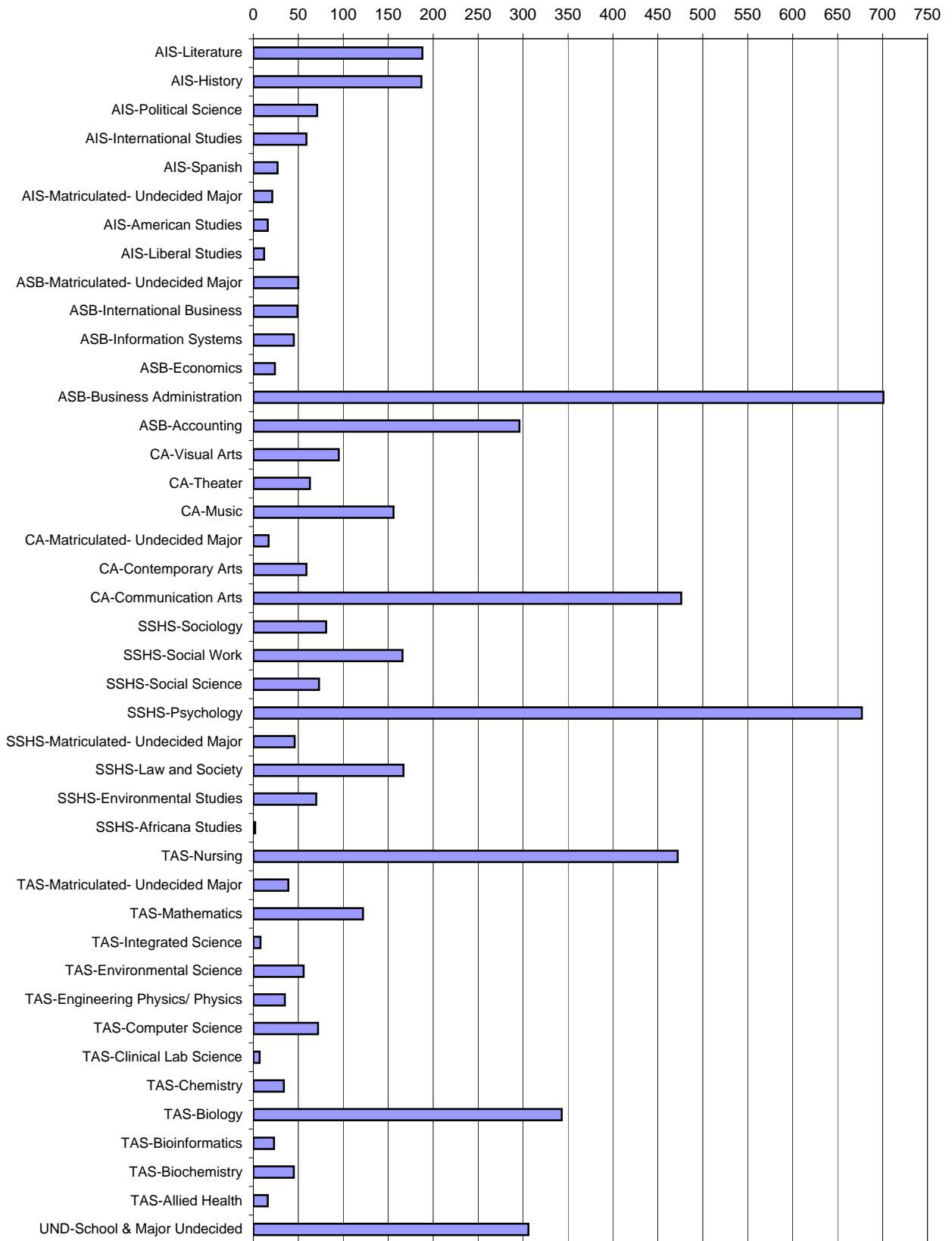

ENROLLMENT BY SCHOOL AND MAJOR**



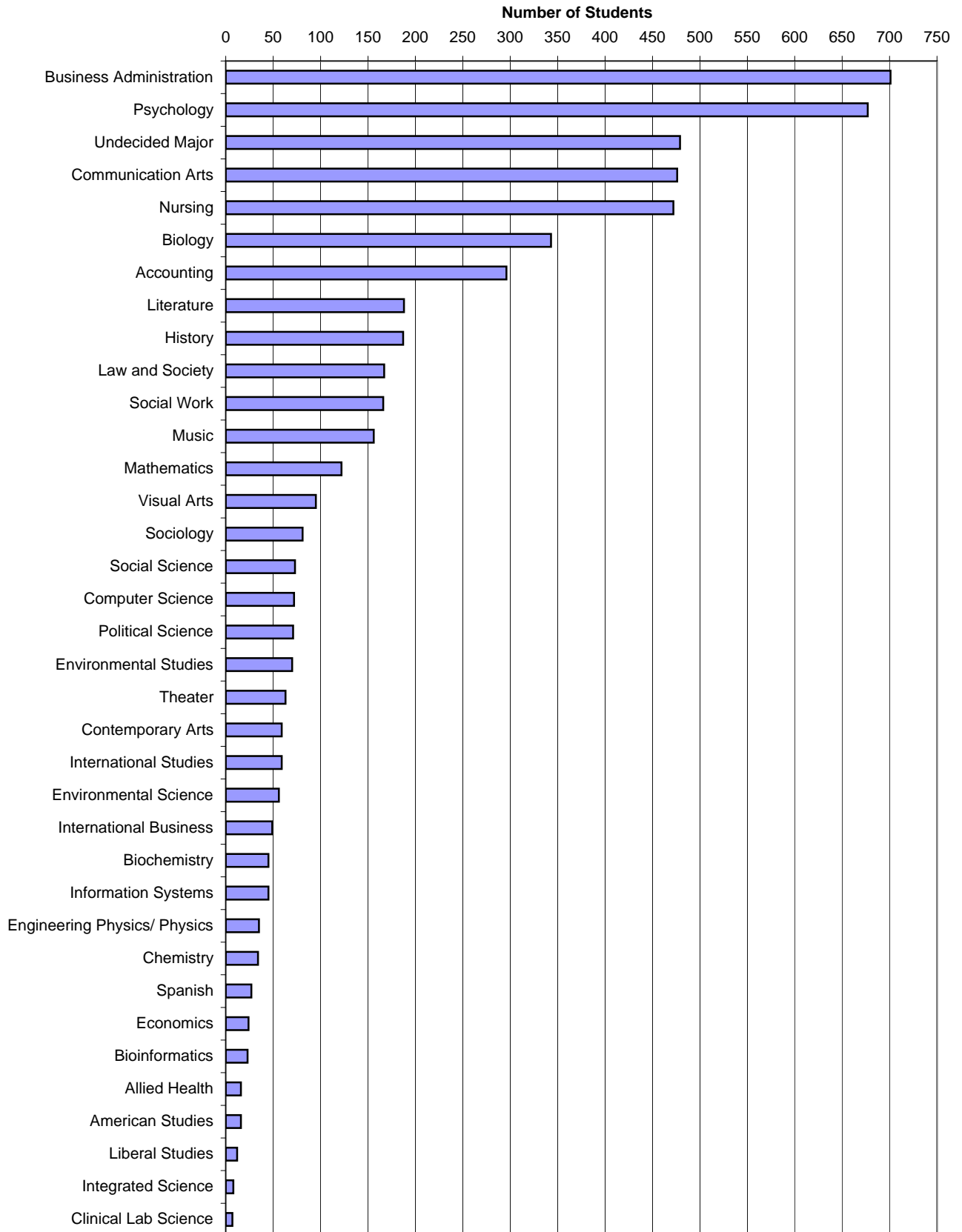

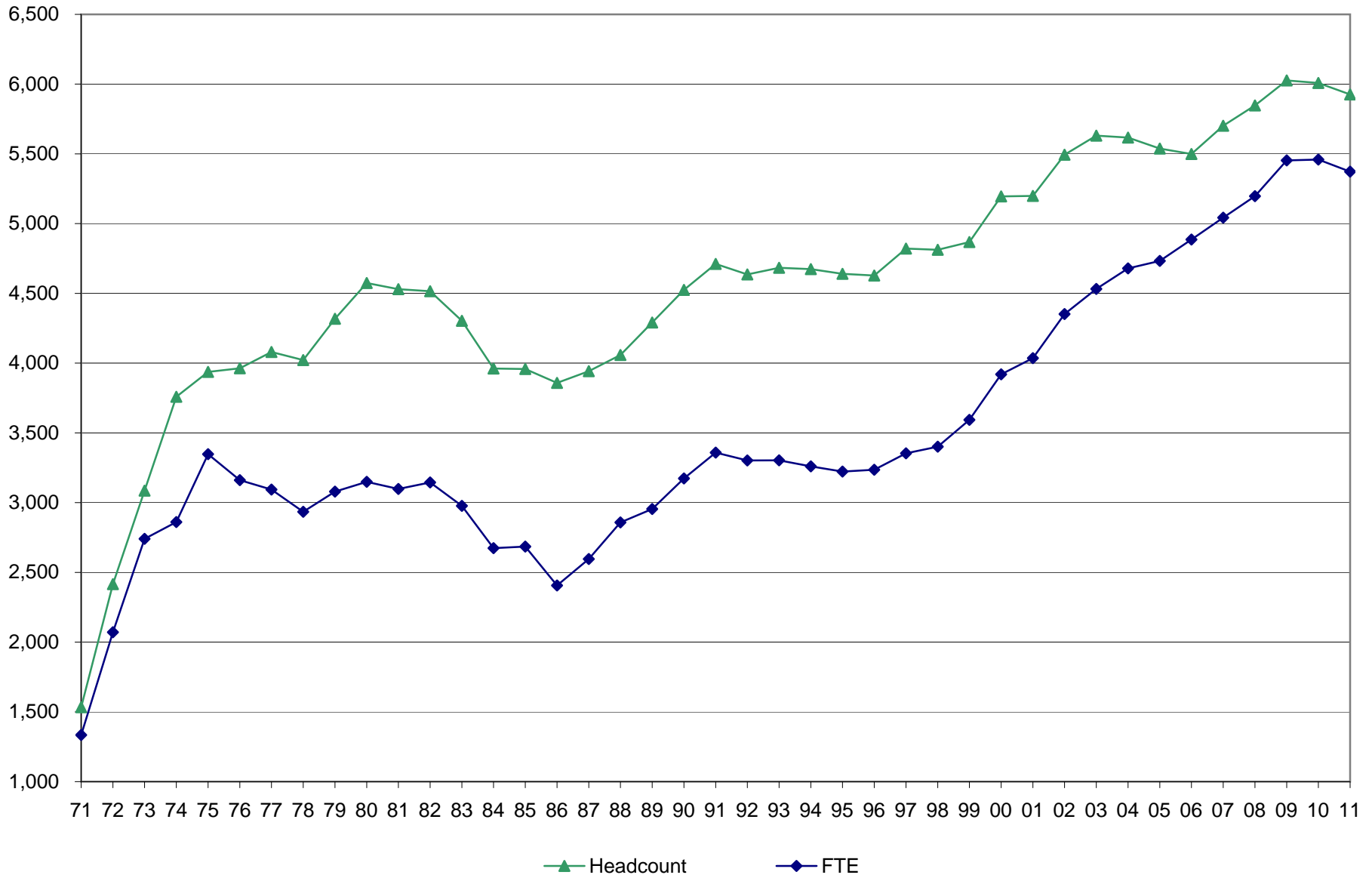

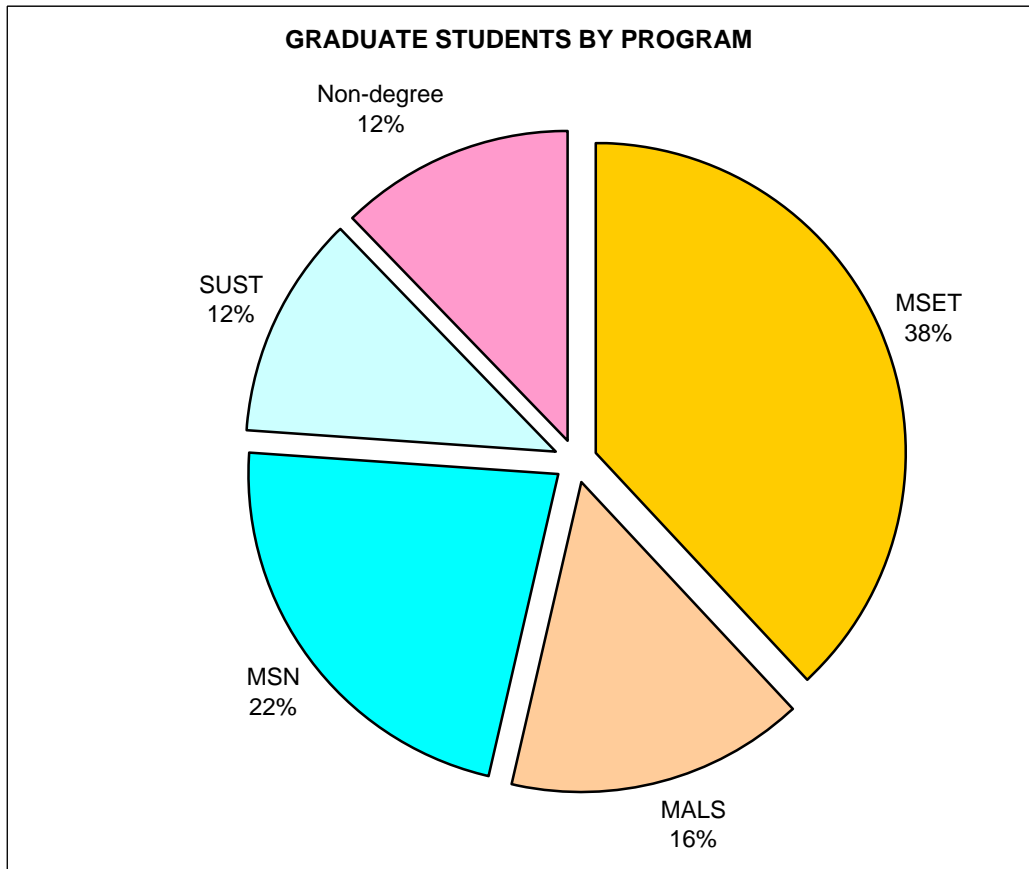
