N.J. IPEDS Form #11: FALL APPLICATIONS AND ADMISSIONS

To submit your completed survey to the Research Unit in the Office of the Secretary of Higher Education, email this file to research@oshe.nj.gov or drop it in your designated moveIT folder.

Applications Section: Report the numbers of applications received. At the undergraduate level, they should be "complete" application (usually involving proper completion of an application form, submission of a high school transcript, and payment of an application fee) At the graduate level, the "complete" restriction does not apply.

Offers Made Section: Of the number of preceding applications received, report how many were extended an offer of admission Remember that this must be a subset of (less than or equal to) the original number of applications

Subsequent Enrollments Section: Of the number of offers made, report how many actually enrolled. Remember that this must be a subset of (less than or equal to) the number of offers made.

This section is not intended to capture total fall enrollment figures; it only shows how many of those given offers of admission actually enrolled.

Full-Time vs. Part-Time: This survey no longer requests data by full-time and part-time attendance status.

All applications, acceptances, and subsequent enrollments should be reported as single numbers (both full-time and part-time combined)

First-Time Freshman: A student who has not previously attended any college (unless first attendance occurred during the preceding summer) and who enrolls in degree-credit courses. Include students with advanced standing

New Transfer: A student who enters for the first time but has earned credits from another institution.

Readmitted Student: A student who has interrupted enrollment for at least a full semester
