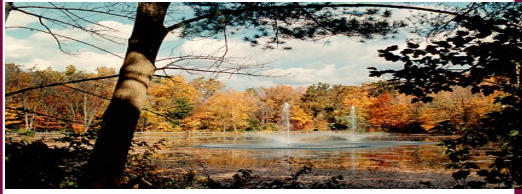

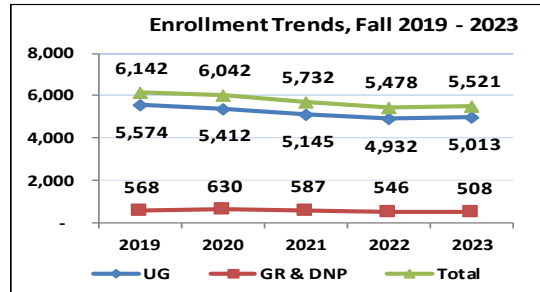

- ◆ Ramapo College remains a top institution in the *US News & World Report* "Best Regional Universities North" category, and ranks #27 among all schools in the same region. Ramapo College is also listed in the "Best Undergraduate Teaching" category and in Best Colleges for Veteran Students.

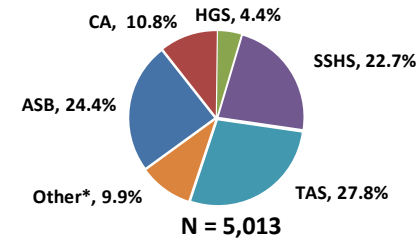

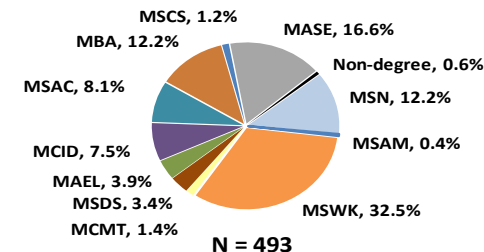

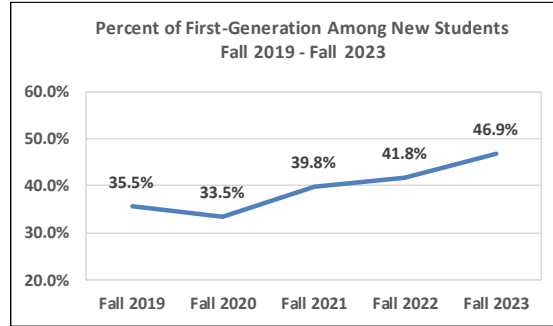
