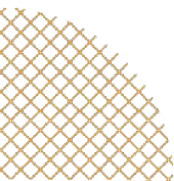


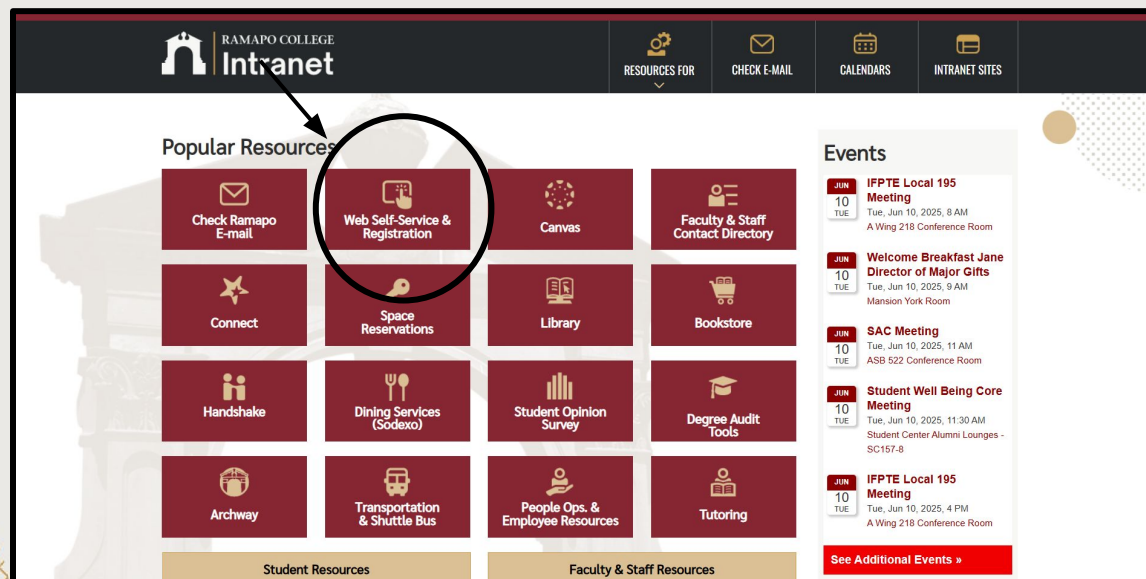
How to Access an Academic Transcript in Web Self-Service

- Go to web.ramapo.edu


