**RUSSIAN AMERICAN KIDS CIRCUS WILL PERFORM AT
RAMAPO COLLEGE**

(Mahwah) – The Russian American Kids Circus, composed of children ages six to 16 trained by veterans of the world-famous Moscow Circus, will perform Sunday, March 26 at 2 p.m. in the Sharp Theater on the campus of Ramapo College.

The performers will dazzle the audience with soaring acrobatics, synchronized unicycling, daring aerial feats, black-light juggling, and of course, clowning. The Russian American Kids Circus has performed in the United States and abroad, combining the artistry and magic of the circus with the rich tradition of European theater and circus. The performance is a synthesis of circus arts, theater, dance, music and comedy.

In addition to stage performances, the Russian American Kids Circus has appeared at the Millennium Celebration at Epcot at Walt Disney World, Florida; on *The Cosby Show*, *Good Morning America*, *Good Day New York*, and television programs in China, Germany, Japan, Mexico and Russia; and was featured in *LIFE Magazine*, *Nick Jr. Magazine*, the *Wall Street Journal* and the *New York Times*, among others.
