LOOSE KNIT WILL BE STAGED AT RAMAPO COLLEGE

(Mahwah) -- The theater program of Ramapo College of New Jersey will present *Loose Knit* February 28, March 1 –2 and March 5 – 7 at 8 p.m. in the Adler Theater on the college campus. Additional performances will be presented March 3 at 2 and 8 p.m. Giovanna Sardelli, whose professional credits include directing plays in New York City, will serve as guest director.

Loose Knit, a play by Theresa Rebeck, revolves around five women who gather each week in New York City to knit. As the sweaters pile up, their lives fall apart. The playwright outlines the battle between the sexes with wit, ferocity and insight in a contemporary comedy of manners.
