The monks are the ones made famous by actor Richard Gere and endorsed by the Dalai Lama. Mystical mask dances, elaborate costumes, traditional instruments and multiphonic singing punctuate a tradition that dates back 2,500 years. The performance is a unique opportunity to experience the special and spectacular culture of Tibet.
