RAMAPO COLLEGE SINGING GROUPS EXCEL AT INTERNATIONAL COMPETITION

(MAHWAH) – Members of three of Ramapo College's singing groups--CantaNOVA, Skylark and Take Twelve--brought home top honors this summer from the International Festival of Academic Choirs in Prague, the Czech Republic.

The Ramapo College contingent was the only American groups invited to the festival. The competition included 17 choirs from South Africa, China, Russia, Slovakia, Hungary, Poland and the Czech Republic.

This was the first time any Ramapo choirs have entered an international competition "I have an enthusiastic core of singers that wanted the opportunities a European tour and competition would bring," said Dr. Lisa Lutter, assistant professor of vocal performance and director of the choirs. The trip was funded by a grant from the Ramapo College Foundation and the Office of the Provost.

Ramapo's three groups won medals in each competition category they entered.

CantaNOVA won a bronze medal and Skylark a silver in the A Cappella category;

CantaNOVA and Skylark each won a silver medal in the Folklore category; CantaNOVA won a silver medal in the World Music category; Skylark won a silver medal in the Jazz category and Take Twelve won a gold medal in the American Songbook category.
