**CONSEQUENCES OF MIDDLE EAST CONFLICT, PERCEIVED BY
PALESTINIAN AND ISRAELI TEENS, SUBJECT OF DOCUMENTARY AT
RAMAPO COLLEGE**

MAHWAH – “*Imagining Peace*,” a documentary about Israeli and Palestinian teenage girls who participated in a women’s leadership program in 2002 called Building Bridges for Peace, will be screened at Ramapo College in October. Director Lisa Gossels will screen segments of the film, which follows the lives of six participants for four years after the program ended, and discuss her work.

Gossels, president of Good Egg Productions, Inc., is an Emmy Award-winning filmmaker. The presentation will be sponsored by Ramapo College’s Center for Holocaust and Genocide Studies and the Communication Arts Major with support from the Office of Student Affairs Platinum Series.
