An Awareness and Fundraising Campaign March 12: Concert for a Cure March 5: Sponsorship Night at Moe's Southwest Grill, Mahwah

MAHWAH - Some of Ramapo College's finest student musicians will perform a concert in March to raise money for the North Jersey Metro Chapter of the Multiple Sclerosis Society.

The performance will feature Tom Nicholes, Rachael Nagy, Andrew Nieporent and the Nonspecifics and The Jay Everett Band, most of whom play regularly on and off campus. Food and beverages will be available and, in addition, attendees will have the opportunity to win raffle prizes that have been donated by area businesses. The event is open to the public.

It will be made possible through co-sponsorship with RamaShows, an on campus organization.
