Ramapo College Presents the Sixth Annual Sebastian J. Raciti Memorial Lecture and Reception with Featured Speaker Dr. Murray Sabrin.

MAHWAH – Ramapo College Professor Murray Sabrin, founder of the Sabrin Center for Business Excellence, will discuss the “Culture of Excellence in American Businesses” at the Sixth Annual Sebastian J. Raciti Memorial Lecture and Dinner at Ramapo College of New Jersey in October.

Sabrin, who with his wife, Florence, has endowed the creation of the Sabrin Center of Business Excellence with a \$250,000 gift, is inaugurating the Center with a talk about business excellence in America.

The annual event was established to honor the memory of Sebastian J. Raciti (1934-2003), who, for 31 years, served in various roles that were instrumental in the development of Ramapo College. Known as Sib, he was a member of the founding faculty, arriving in the College's second year.

The lecture will be sponsored by the Sabrin Center for Business Excellence of Ramapo College, which is located in the Anisfield School of Business.
