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Project Management Boot Camp for Working Professionals Offered In July at Ramapo College

MAHWAH, N.J. – Ramapo College’s Center for Innovative and Professional Learning is offering an intensive 8-hour Project Management Boot Camp in July for working professionals. Attend on the Ramapo College campus in Mahwah on two Mondays, July 11 and July 13, from 12:30 to 4:30 p.m.

Over the two half-day sessions, participants will learn the basics of project management, create tools to effectively manage projects such as a project scope statement, work breakdown structure and project schedule, and review risk analysis and how to develop prevention strategies. Three hours of online pre-work is also required.
