Economist, Editor Will Examine Trump's Economic Policies: 'The Good, Bad and the Ugly'

MAHWAH, N.J. – The Sabrin Center for Free Enterprise and the Anisfield School of Business at Ramapo College of New Jersey present "Examining President Donald Trump's Economic Policies: The Good, the Bad and the Ugly" on Tuesday, March 27 at 7:30 p.m. in Friends Hall.

Robert Wenzell, editor and publisher of *EconomicPolicyJournal.com* and *Target Liberty*, will be the featured speaker for the event, which is free and open to the public. Wenzell will discuss the good and many dangers in "Trumponomics" and why it may lead to many undesirable events such as accelerating price inflation and a lower standard of living for all.

Wenzell is well known for forecasting the 2008 financial crisis in real time and for challenging New York Federal Reserve economists in 2005, who argued that there was no developing housing bubble. Prior to launching his websites, he spent 30 years on Wall Street advising companies on financial alternatives across a broad spectrum of industries including the pharmaceutical and film industries.

He is the author of "The Fed Flunks: My Speech at the New York Federal Reserve Bank." A frequent guest on radio talk shows, he has been quoted in *The Wall Street Journal, The New York Times, Forbes, Bloomberg, ZeroHedge, LewRockwell.com*, at *CNBC* and other media outlets.
