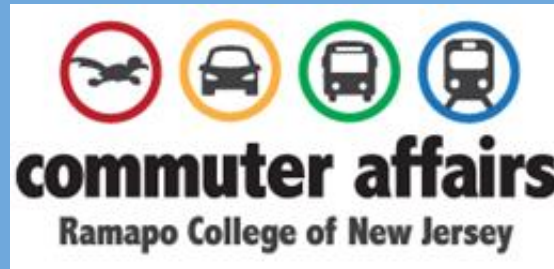

Campus Parking Information

How to apply for parking?

- Students can select parking by accessing their web-self service portal and pay for parking access.
- Once paid, your parking pass should arrive in the mail by mid August
- Information will be provided this summer for the Public Safety website about parking payments for all commuter students.

Where to park on campus?

- Commuter students are encouraged to park in the Commuter lots (B-lot)
- General parking is also allowed in lot D for all Ramapo students

Campus Parking Information

Parking Permits

- Once you pay and apply for parking, you will get a temporary parking pass for your dashboard
- Must be displayed while parking on campus as a commuter student
- You can register up to two cars per student for your parking permit.
- The pass will be mailed to your home within 7 to 10 business days.
- If you don't receive your parking pass in 14 business days, contact parking@ramapo.edu

RCNJ Off Campus Shuttle

- The RCNJ shuttle runs daily for the Fall & Spring semesters with a train express shuttle and a local shuttle.
- You can access the RCNJ shuttle schedule on the CSI Transportation website that will have times to pick ups and drop offs for the Fall 2025 semester.
- The shuttle is free for all students and guests to use located at the Bradley Center



Ramsey Route 17 & Garden State Plaza

Ramsey Route 17 Station

- Travel to local areas in NJ & connections to NYC via Secaucus Junction & Hoboken Terminal
- Express train shuttle pick up & drop offs to Ramapo

Garden State Plaza

- Local pick up & drop off times
- Shopping center, movie theater, & more
- Weekday & Weekend options for students to use

NJ Student Pass Information

Student Pass — Unlimited Monthly Travel

NJ TRANSIT has expanded its Student Pass fare option to include eligible part-time students. In addition to full-time students, part-time degree seeking students taking at least two courses will also be eligible for the Student Pass fare.

As a full-time or part-time degree-seeking student, you can save an extra 25% on your NJ TRANSIT Monthly Pass when your school participates in our University Partnership Program.

NJ Student Pass Information

How to Sign Up for Student Pass:

Log onto your school website

Search for “Student Pass” or NJ TRANSIT to find the registration web page

Follow the steps on screen to complete the registration and verify your student email address

Then download the NJ TRANSIT Mobile App and enter your Student Pass login information
