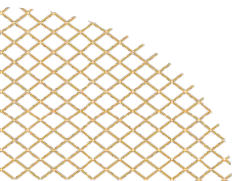



Student Well-Being Core Goals

- **Well-Being**: Maximize student well-being through support programs and activities
 - **Access, Belonging, and Community**: Offer programs that deliver educational, engaging, and reflective experiences for students
 - **Community Responsibility**: Design policies, procedures, and programs that provide students with the framework for responsible decision making
 - **Student Engagement**: Provide opportunities for students to develop their leadership potential while being active academically, socially, personally, and civically in the community and beyond

Student Communications

- Ramapo email is the official means of communication with your student. Everything - registration, housing, campus closings, etc.
- Daily Digest - daily listing of events, programs, services
- Archway - campus engagement platform that connects students with groups, events, and each other
- OnCampusText - opt-in text messages
- In the Loop and Weekend Edition
- Rocky (chatbot)
- Social Media

Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA)

- Once a student enrolls at Ramapo, Federal law protects the security of, privacy of, and limits access to student educational records.
- The rights have now officially switched from the parents (K-12) to the student, regardless of student's age:
- Federal law:
 - *allows* certain members of the campus community to discuss your student's academic record, tuition bill, financial aid, conduct issues, etc.
 - *does not allow* unlimited access



Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) POST ORIENTATION

- Engage in a discussion with your student about the level of information and sharing that should exist on their records
- If your student wants to seek out a FERPA waiver form, they are available in the [Office of the Registrar](#), D224, but must be picked up, signed and submitted by the student, or can be submitted from the student's email account, with a penned signature.
- Students can revoke/change their FERPA waivers at any time.



Need to Know

 - Blue Lights

 - Campus Shuttles (commuters to train stations and residential to local area attractions)
 - NYC Bus (managed by Coach USA, tickets at CSI)

Prevention at Ramapo

First year students are **REQUIRED** to complete five (5) online educational modules prior to coming to RCNJ

- AlcoholEDU
- CannabisEDU
- Sexual Assault Prevention
- Mental Well-Being
- Diversity, Equity & Inclusion

Students begin modules August 3rd

- Part 1 is due August 28th
- Part 2 is due in mid-October

**Failure to complete all parts by mid-October results in a Registration hold
for Spring 2027 courses**
