First Year Seminar is taken in the first semester. Failure to complete CRWT and MATH will result in a hold when the student hits 64 credits. ⁺W: Students transferring in with 48 or more credits are waived from these general education requirements.

- * Students may take 18 credits without additional tuition.
- ** Incoming music majors must take Musicianship placement test to determine appropriate placement. If a student scores 74 or below on this test, take MUSI 120-Music Fundamentals in first term and proceed with the Musicianship sequence thereafter.
- *** This Concentration allows for eight electives, which means students can add a second music concentration, a certificate, a minor, or possibly a second major. Speak with your academic advisor for more details.
- **** Many 200-level Music and Culture courses count for the Gen Ed category of Culture and Creativity (CC); check the Catalog. One of the Music and Culture courses (200 or 300 Level) must be on the "International Focus" list in the Music Studies Concentration.
