First Year Seminar is taken in the first semester. Failure to complete CRWT and MATH will result in a hold when the student hits 64 credits. BADM 120 Excel Expert Certification Prep (2 cr.) is recommended for all Finance majors in the second year, second semester.

Students must earn a grade of “C” or better in FINC 301 in order to take FINC 302 Corporate Finance II

* FINC 321 Securities & Investments may be taken any semester *after* completing FINC 301 Corporate Finance I.

**** The ASB Career Pathways Program is managed through the ASB Career Services Office, ASB-513, which documents module completion. The Registrar is then notified and the course for that module is posted to the student's record. All ASB Career Pathways courses must be completed prior to graduation.**
