**Example 3:** The *Social Science Inquiry* course shown below is an **Online Course**. Students will learn course content by independently completing fully asynchronous learning experiences. Online courses do not hold any in-person, on-campus class meetings or virtual synchronous class meetings via WebEx, Zoom, etc. Instead, a student interacts with course material, the instructor, and other students enrolled in the course through Ramapo’s learning management system, “Canvas.” Students must still meet instructor-established deadlines for submitting assigned work, which is to be completed on their own time. Although no on-campus presence is required to participate in an online course, students who do not have reliable internet off campus may utilize computer labs or study rooms on campus.
