## VI. Speaker - Michael Yankovich (VP of Operational and Administrative Integration)

- a. Comprehensive Facilities Plan
  - i. A Ramapo environment vision for next 10 years. Produced from participation from different members of campus including students.
  - ii. Focuses more on renovation and renewal rather than construction of new infrastructure. Emphasis is on student growth.
  - iii. Focus on smaller classrooms than building large lecture halls.
  - iv. Feedback that was received in the planning process:
    - 1. Location of the Student Health and Residence life center is not accessible.
    - 2. Nursing labs are oversubscribed. Trying to find a way to upscale our nursing building.

  - 1. First floor Public Safety

  - 3. Second Floor Counseling Services so it's close to Health Services

  - 6. Residence life, student mail will be moved to C Wing where HR and public safety is. The space left will be for student activities and clubs.
