 - 1. Joe- Sustainability committee wants to figure out how to stop the birding strikes. We wanted to see if we could have students paint murals on the windows so the birds stop hitting them.
 - a. Mihir- To add we want to just put decals on the windows but they are expensive so the school board is not going to buy them. So our alternative is to block windows with murals.

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- i. Peter- I like this idea, I think the fishbowl has some right now. We would need a lot of ladders though because they are hitting the top ones more. So this would be a safety issue concerning students falling. I do think this is a great idea but I don't know if they'll allow it.
- ii. Gianna- Are there any high priorities areas?
 1. Peter- the windows by the arch are the most important ones.
- iii. Joe- Another big issue is having a high grade paint to have it stick on the windows.
- iv. Peter- Spray paint is the best option we have. It is the least expensive idea, but all of the murals would be up within the next 2 years though.
 1. Joe- we could use stencils with the spray paint
 2. Peter- that would be a great idea and we'd only need like 10 cans.
- v. James - Why would it be a 2 year thing?
 1. Peter- It would require a lot of funding and it's up to Goldstein to see what he thinks. It is also a lot of work to get students involved and facilities to approve the windows being spray painted.
- vi. Sebastian- Would this be a summer thing?
 1. Peter- It would probably be a fall thing.
 2. Joe- This would have to be an early fall because migration.
- vii. Joe- I know you want to bring this to Goldstein, but I think Kaitlyn O'Connor is leading the bird strikes and with Goldstein I think there are a lot of people involved already.

- viii. Mihir- We can definitely help you after you meet with Goldstein and after you decide what materials we are using.
