## **Understanding a Macro Placement**

- Students are expected to complete macro tasks such as:
  - Arrange/organize public meetings
  - Program evaluation Direct outreach activities
  - Lobbying
  - Sustain the organization (creating materials, mailings, fundraising)
  - Community planning
  - Identify and understand decision making process power structure of agency
  - Attending and testifying at legislative or public forums
  - Apply community organization methods
  - Grant writing
  - Social policy analysis
  - Address relevent power structure
  - Program planning
  - Administrative tasks
  - Research Advocacy
- ⇒ Formal supervision sessions are not required. Instead, students should be provided oversight by the supervisor throughout the duration of the placement.

Students will keep track of hours using an electronic timesheet. Agency  $\ni$  supervisors will have access to the timesheet for accountability purposes.

## Wrapping Up the Semester

 Supervisors will receive a link to the end of semester evaluation via email. Students should take part in the evaluation process.
Evaluations are due by the last day of the semester.
