The Office of Title IX ("Title IX") is dedicated to protecting the safety of our community and facilitating a transparent, fair and just process for resolving reports of sexual misconduct. Title IX provides resources, support, and information to all community members impacted by sexual misconduct. Title IX also provides education, training and awareness-raising to reduce the incidence of sexual misconduct in our community.

- » Explain the survivor's rights and options;
- » Provide support and safety measures as needed (e.g., medical treatment, counseling, academic support, housing accommodations, No Contact Order. etc.):
- » Connect to resources (Counseling » Learn the survivor's preferences and Health Services, Office of Violence Prevention, Women's Center & LGBTQ Services, YWCA Northern NJ healingSPACE, etc.);
- » Help identify personal support systems; and
- about further investigation and resolution. The College will take all reasonable steps to honor a survivor's preferences to initiate (or not initiate) an investigation.\*\*\*
