

ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

Between
Ramapo College of New Jersey
And
Rockland Community College

This articulation agreement defines terms under which Rockland Community College graduates who transfer directly and matriculate at Ramapo College of New Jersey within one year of receiving their associate's degree. In addition, it will apply to anyone that has graduated from Rockland Community College with an AA/AS and has not earned credits elsewhere in the last 3 years. These students will receive a 50% discount on the out-of-state tuition surcharge until they have earned their first baccalaureate degree. Enrollment at Ramapo College must be continuous to benefit from the tuition discount.

This agreement will become effective as of the Fall 2019 semester, beginning for newly enrolled students as of September 1, 2019.

While this articulation agreement pertains only to a financial arrangement between Rockland Community College and Ramapo College, it can be anticipated that it will lead to further cooperative endeavors and program-to-program academic course articulations. In brief, it provides a foundation for the continual expansion of mutually beneficial relations between the two institutions.
