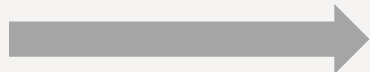

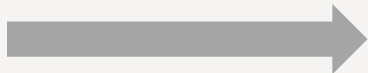

Academic Rights & Responsibilities



	RIGHTS	RESPONSIBILITIES
Academic Progress	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• make up course work if permitted by professor/ according to information on syllabus• credit overload• summer/winter term courses	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• declare major and “follow” 4-year plan (monitor degree audit) to complete all graduation requirements• complete CRWT 102 and gen ed Quantitative Reasoning requirements before earning 64 credits• maintain GPA required for graduation

Academic Rights & Responsibilities



ISSUE	RIGHTS	RESPONSIBILITIES
Academic Challenges	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• communicate with your instructors & advisors• request an incomplete (<i>if eligible</i>) or withdraw by the stated deadline• use a “Repeat Course” option• appeal a course grade• appeal academic suspension or dismissal	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• ask for help, deadline extension, extra support/resources• know the Academic Calendar• complete and submit a Repeat Course form• document your academic performance – organize all records that support your grade appeal and submit by deadline (see Academic Calendar)• regularly read your Ramapo email; submit your appeal by deadline

Academic Rights & Responsibilities



ISSUE	RIGHTS	RESPONSIBILITIES
Academic Integrity	<ul style="list-style-type: none">attend an Academic Integrity Hearing with the Vice Provost or with the Academic Integrity Board if reported for a violation (plagiarism, cheating, academic misconduct, fabrication)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">do not violate the Academic Integrity Policy – uphold academic integrity

ACADEMIC INTEGRITY POLICY

All members of the community are expected to be honest and forthright in their academic endeavors. Since violations of academic integrity erode community confidence and undermine the pursuit of truth and knowledge at the College, academic dishonesty is not acceptable.

Definitions - Academic Integrity

Honesty & Integrity!



1. **Cheating** – a student misrepresents their mastery of material on a homework assignment, paper, test, or other exercise; ex: using unauthorized materials during an exam
1. **Plagiarism** – the writer or speaker does not cite the source of words, phrases, sentences, data, or even ideas that should be attributed to/belonged to an original author, speaker, thinker, etc.; also note “self-plagiarism” in the Policy
1. **Academic Misconduct** – someone behaves in a way that is academically dishonest; e.g., altering grades, acquiring or distributing an unadministered test, submitting the same work in more than one class without both instructors’ awareness
1. **Fabrication** – someone uses invented information or falsifies research, data, findings, etc; e.g., including sources in a “works cited page” that were not actually used, forging signatures on forms, submitting work that was done by someone else
